You have failed to notify this office of beginning of actual construction work under your permit No. Some time ago you were notified that such notice should be filed showing that actual construction work was commenced on or before ~~the date specified in the permit~~ and we have had no reply to this notification.

~~August 20th, 1921.~~
Failure to begin actual construction work on or before the above date operates to invalidate your permit. Unless we have definite assurance from you within sixty days from the date hereof that actual construction work was commenced within the time specified in the permit the same will be referred to the Board for appropriate action.

We feel sure that you desire to cooperate with us in this matter and we will greatly appreciate it if you will authorize the cancellation of your permit on the records of this office in case you have failed to begin actual construction work. In case you have disposed of the land upon which the water was to be used, an assignment of the water right should be filed for record in this office. We will be glad to receive a renewal of the right through the filing of a new application, should you so desire.
