I, L.E. Williams of 8274 Mill Creek Road, SE, Aumsville, Oregon 97325, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the legal owner of lands shown in yellow on the attached map and the water right appurtenant thereto.

The water right in question is for appropriation of not to exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second of water from Porter Creek for the irrigation of:

10.0 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4  
Section 35  
Township 8 South, Range 2 West, WM

With a date of priority of July 12, 1922 as evidenced by the certificate recorded at page 34960, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Donker Brothers.

Having obtained a better source of water for the primary irrigation of these lands, I request the right therefore described be diminished from a right for primary irrigation to a right for supplemental irrigation of the same lands.

I agree that if this change is approved, it is permanent and the right to the use of water from Porter Creek cannot be changed back to the primary source. I also agree that so long as there is sufficient water available from the new primary source, I am not entitled to use any water from Porter Creek for irrigation of said lands.

On July 5, 1985, an affidavit was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by L.E. Williams for approval of a change from primary to supplemental use of water from Porter Creek.

The certificate recorded at page 34960, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Donker Brothers, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second from Porter Creek for irrigation of 10.0 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 35, Township 8 South, Range 2 West, WM, with a date of priority of July 12, 1922.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 8 South, Range 2 West, WM.

The affiant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the right from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation on the same lands.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed diminution of water right may be made without injury to existing rights, the petition should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 34960, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and a new certificate of water right be issued to the applicant herein designating said water right as supplemental on the aforesaid lands.
