Low berms (18 inches to 2 feet high) will be constructed along either side of the ditch, and along the west side of each wetland area, creating two separate impoundments. These impoundments will be filled by natural seepage and runoff during the wet season. A pump will be used to withdraw water from the unnamed ditch during the month of October to provide additional storage of water in the impoundments during a short period before the wet season begins. + For Department Use Permit No. App. No. **R-87807**

The berms (i.e., dams) which are to be constructed on two sides of each low lying, wetland area are intended to enhance the natural impoundment of seasonally high water. There is no intention or need to provide outlet conduits in the "dams."

- Even if the Department issues a permit, I may have to stop using water to allow senior water right holders to get water to which they are entitled.

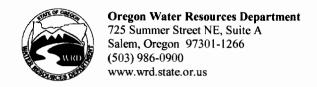

NOTE TO APPLICANTS

In order for your application to be processed by the Water Resources Department (WRD), this Land Use Information Form must be completed by a local government planning official in the jurisdiction(s) where your water right will be used and developed. The planning official may choose to complete the form while you wait, or return the receipt stub to you. Applications received by WRD without the Land Use Form or the receipt stub will be returned to you. Please be aware that your application will not be approved without land use approval.

This form is NOT required if:

- 1) Water is to be diverted, conveyed, and/or used only on federal lands; OR
- 2) The application is for a water right transfer, allocation of conserved water, exchange, permit amendment, or ground water registration modification, and all of the following apply:
 - a) The existing and proposed water use is located entirely within lands zoned for exclusive farm-use or within an irrigation district;
 - b) The application involves a change in place of use only;
 - c) The change does not involve the placement or modification of structures, including but not limited to water diversion, impoundment, distribution facilities, water wells and well houses; and
 - d) The application involves irrigation water uses only.

NOTE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

The person presenting the attached Land Use Information Form is applying for or modifying a water right. The Water Resources Department (WRD) requires its applicants to obtain land-use information to be sure the water rights do not result in land uses that are incompatible with your comprehensive plan. Please complete the form or detach the receipt stub and return it to the applicant for inclusion in their water right application. You will receive notice once the applicant formally submits his or her request to the WRD. The notice will give more information about WRD's water rights process and provide additional comment opportunities. You will have 30 days from the date of the notice to complete the land-use form and return it to the WRD. If no land-use information is received from you within that 30-day period, the WRD may presume the land use associated with the proposed water right is compatible with your comprehensive plan. 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WATER RESOURCES DEPT SALEM, OREGON A tract of land in Section 32, Township 3 North, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Multnomah County, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of Oak Island Road which is 442.85 feet South and 1568.59 feet West of a concrete monument set at the meander corner on the East side of said Section 32; thence along the center line of said Oak Island Road as follows: South 80° 55' West 500.98 feet; thence Southwesterly along the arc of a 573.14 foot radius curve to the left 116.04 feet; South 69° 19' West 193.5 feet; thence leaving said road, North 20° 41' West (passing an iron pipe at 20 feet) 1995.6 feet to a point in the center of Gilbert River; thence Southeasterly along the center line of Gilbert river, 442 feet, more or less to a point on the East line of the Northwest quarter of said Section 32; thence South along said East line 148.7 feet to an iron pipe set at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of Section 32; thence South 89° 43' East 294 feet, more or less, to an iron pipe which bears North 29° 22' West from the point of beginning; thence South 29° 22' East 1597.95 feet to the point of beginning, EXCEPT THEREFROM the Southerly portion in Oak Island Road or any other road or highway; EXCEPTING all rights of way established by decree in partition suit entered December 22, 1915, Leonard vs. Walker, et al, Reg. D-1346.
