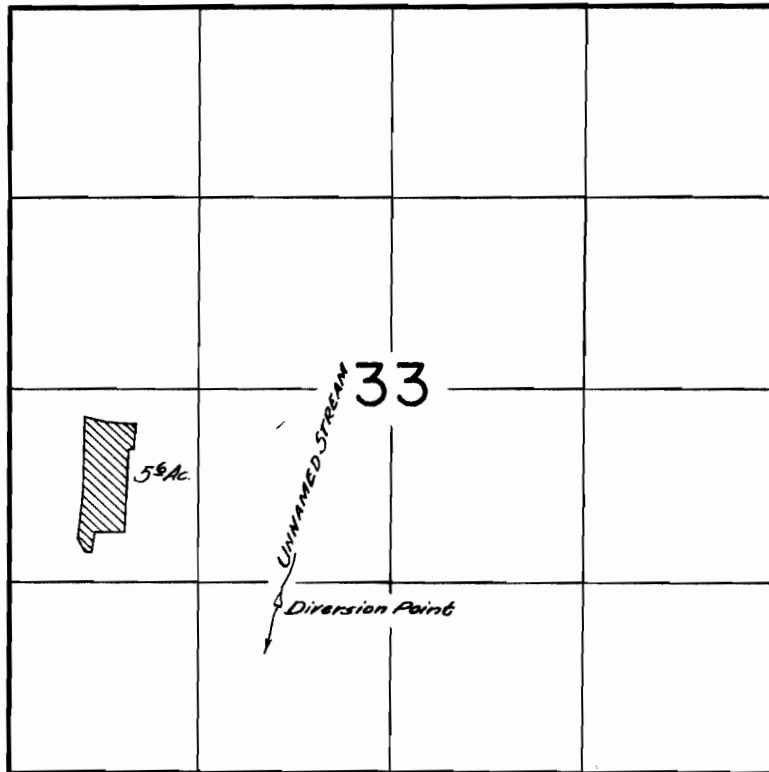

On May 12, 1967, Roy Peters submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of 5.6 acres in the NW 1/4, Section 33, Township 31 South, Range 15 West, T.M., and the water right appurtenant thereto; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the use of 0.20 cubic foot per second of said water right for the harvesting of cranberries and request the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the use of not to exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Summers Creek, for the harvesting of cranberries within NW 1/4, Section 33, Township 31 South, Range 15 West, T.M., with dates of priority of April 14, 1961 for 0.06 cubic foot per second and August 22, 1961 for 0.74 cubic foot per second, and is evidenced by certificate of water right issued in the name of Florence M. Sumwalt and recorded at page 32063, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

Dear Mr. Zumwalt:

Upon consideration of your application for approval by issuance of a permit, it is noted in your original letter of transmittal that you wish to appropriate water for the harvesting of cranberries in addition to the irrigation described in your application.

If it is your intention to appropriate water for the flood harvesting of cranberries, this should be stated in item 3 of your application. The right allowed for flood harvesting would be sub-ordinate and inferior to future appropriations from this source for domestic, stock and irrigation purposes. 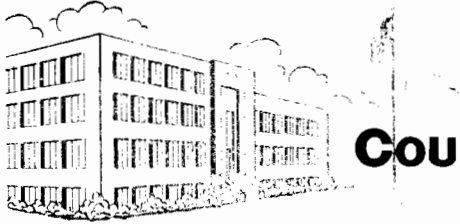

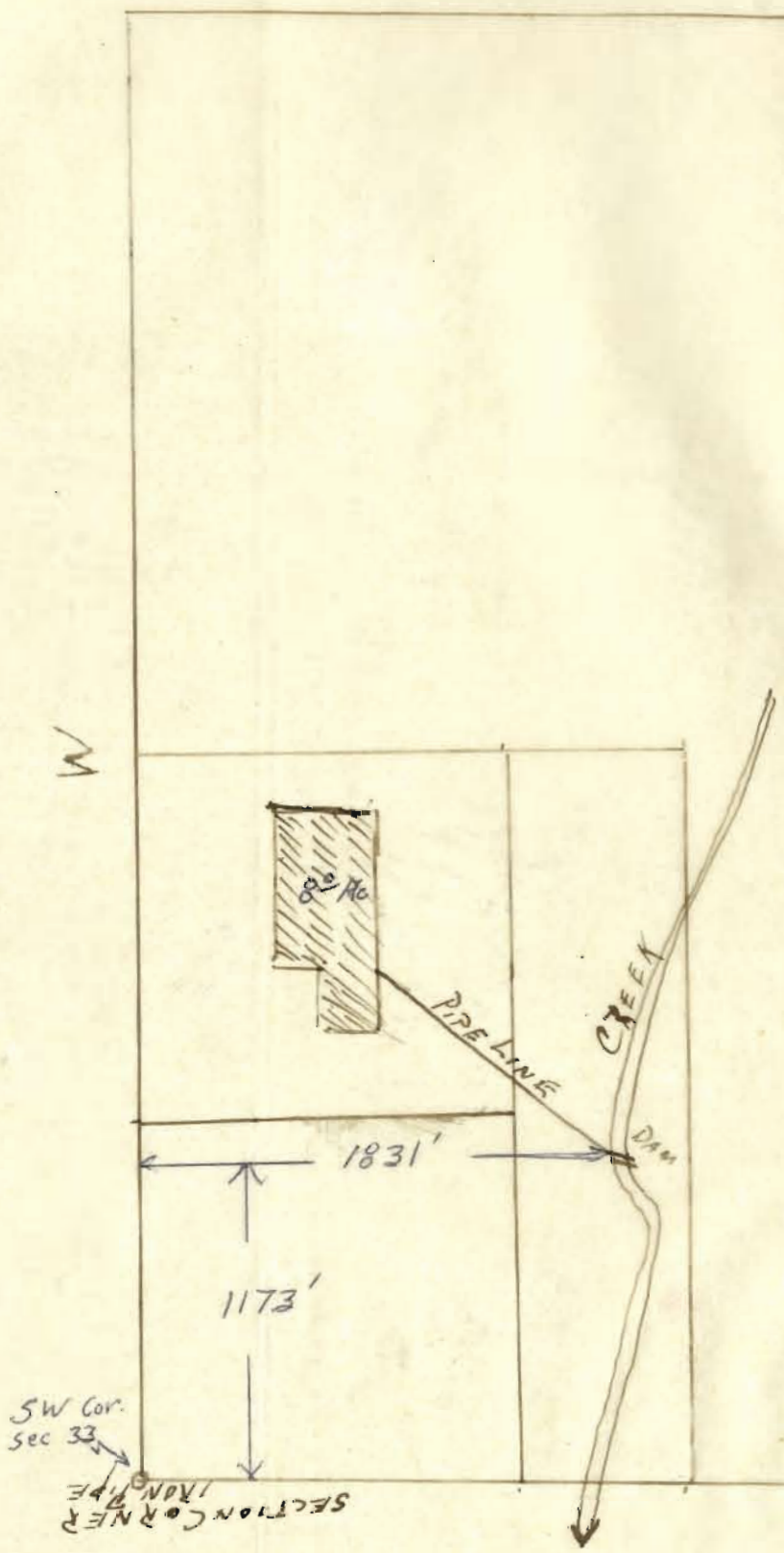
