

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated April 13, 1961, submitting an application for a permit to appropriate an unspecified amount of water from an unnamed tributary of Summer Creek for the irrigation of 8.0 acres of cranberries, a sketch map and fees in the sum of \$15.00 for which our receipt numbered 29382 is enclosed.

Your application has been examined and filed under file number 34807. Before it may be considered for approval, it must be completed as follows:

- Item 2: The quantity of water which you intend to apply to beneficial use must be specified. The maximum amount of water which may be authorized under this application as it is now written is 0.2 cubic foot per second.
- Item 4: The point of diversion must be located in reference from an established identified government survey corner.
- Item 8: The number of acres to be irrigated within each quarter quarter section must be specified.
- Items 11-14: These items must be completed.
- Map: The map required to accompany your application must be prepared in accordance with the provisions set forth on pages 7 and 8 of the enclosed copy of the Rules and Regulations of the State Engineer.

Legal Description: It will be necessary that you submit a legal description of the property upon which the water will be used. This should be copied word for word from your deed, abstract, title insurance policy or sales contract.

Your application and sketch map are returned for completion, the application being endorsed so that in order to retain its date of priority it must be returned to this office on or before June 28, 1961.
