that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the ~~SW 1/4 of Section 18~~, Township 4 S, Range 1 E, W. M. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighthieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (if for irrigation, or any other purpose), is as follows:

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.







I discussed certificates 9763, and 9764 and Permit 25259 with Armin Netter this date.

Mr. Netter says that most of the land shown on final proof survey map was irrigated by a series of ditches under the two early rights and that some land has been added along with the use of water from the slough under Permit 25259. He believes that all of the rights under certificates 9763 and 9764 to be correct for lands north of the slough and the acreages should be deleted from Permit 25259. He believes an error exists in 9764 and 2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , 2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 13 and land south of slough in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 13 should be canceled and this land would then have a primary right from the slough. The balance of the land the final proof survey map shows irrigated from slough will have a supplemental right from slough (primary under older rights).

Proof under Permit 25259 will be made accordingly and sent along with affidavit to cancel part of certificate 9764.

Dear Mr. Netter:

This will acknowledge your application for a permit to construct a reservoir and to store therein 5.4 acre feet of water from Netter Creek for irrigation, a small dam data sheet and the fee of \$20 for which our receipt number 25725 was handed to you. This application has been filed and numbered R-48754.

Also acknowledged is your application for a permit to appropriate 0.47 cubic foot of water per second from the reservoir and Netter Creek for irrigation, being 0.28 cubic foot of water per second for the supplemental irrigation of 37.4 acres and 0.19 cubic foot of water per second for the primary irrigation of 15.4 acres, a reproducible map and the fee of \$21.60 for which our receipt number 25724 was handed to you. This application has been filed and numbered 48755.

Also acknowledged is your letter of January 4, 1972, inquiring about the status of your applications. I apologize for the delay in responding.

Items Number 8, 9, and 13 must be completed on your reservoir application number R-48754.

Also, the distance between the top of the dam and the bottom of the spillway must be indicated on your small dam data sheet in the spillway section, along with indicating the size and type of outlet pipe in the base of the dam.

The 36-inch culvert to be used as your spillway as indicated on the small dam data sheet is of insufficient capacity to pass the 50-year peak flow.

Your application map and your secondary application number 48755 indicate that you propose to use the water for primary irrigation and supplemental irrigation. As mentioned when you were in this office when the applications were filed, most of the lands shown on your application map have existing

rights evidenced by certificates recorded at pages 29169, 9763, and 29471, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The location of these lands are shown on the enclosed copy of our final proof survey map and are further described as follows.

1. Certificate of water right recorded at page 29169 evidences a right to the use of 0.1 cubic foot of water per second from two unnamed streams for the irrigation of 3.0 acres in the SW<sub>1</sub>, NE<sub>1</sub>, and 4.6 acres in the NW<sub>1</sub>, SW<sub>1</sub> of Section 13, Township 4 South, Range 1 West, W. Dear Mr. Rettler:

As discussed with you when you were in this office over this age, I have prepared an Affidavit concerning the certificates issued to Elgin Rettler recorded on Page 9760 State Board of Water Rights Certificate. You will recall that there was some conflict between this and the certificates issued to Elgin Rettler recorded on Page 9763 State Board of Water Rights Certificates. The land described under the certificate recorded on Page 9761, together with the land described in the certificates recorded on Page 9763, covers the total area irrigated north of the slough in Section 13.

If you will sign this affidavit and have your signature witnessed and return the affidavit together with the certificates recording fee of \$1, we will return the certificates currently describing the lands irrigated.

Also enclosed is a draft of the proposed certificate in connection with your permit No. 15209. This describes the appropriation of water from Rettler Creek for lands not previously covered and also the appropriation of water from the slough for lands not having a previous water right and supplemental supply on 3/5 acres which has a primary right from Rettler Creek. If you will date and sign this draft under "Visual Proof" and return it together with the certificates recording fee of \$1, we will issue the connecting certificate.

If you prefer and if it is convenient, you could bring these forms to the office for fuller explanation and we will go over this with you and the affidavit could also be witnessed.

Dear Mr. Nettler:

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate 100 gallons per minute of water from a lake for irrigation and domestic use accompany the application. The application cannot be filed since it was not accompanied by the statutory fees; however, it has been checked over and a fee discrepancy noted.

The source of water which you have described as a lake is not entirely clear. From the addition which you have made to the sketch of the Portland General Electric Company's, it would appear to be a portion of the stream system of Nettler and Burkart Creeks, which originally have been a channel of the Pudding River.

The acreage which you have shown on your sketch do not agree with the acreage listing which you have given under item 6 of the application. However, it appears to be approximately the same acreage as that indicated in your application for use of the waters of Nettler and Burkart Creeks.

If you have abandoned the use of water from Nettler and Burkart Creeks as shown on the certificates recorded on Pages 9763 and 9764, Water Right of Water Rights Certificate, the cancellation of these rights should be anticipated prior to proceeding with the new application.

Under item 6 of the application, it is not clear what your plans are but if you intend to create artificial storage within the channel of the stream or slough, it will be necessary to file a separate application for that purpose.

Further action on your application will be withheld pending receipt of your explanation of what your plans are.

Dear Madam:

Your Permits Nos. 4643 and 4792, which grant the right to the use of 0.25 second-feet of water from two small unnamed streams for domestic and irrigation of 20 acres, and 0.26 second-foot of water from two unnamed streams for irrigation of 21 acres, respectively, have been brought to my attention.

Our records indicate that final proof under these permits was made in 1925, but that upon the inspection by a representative from this office, it was evident that the appropriations had not been entirely completed and that you wished additional time to include the remaining acreage. Extensions of time were therefore granted under Permit No. 4645 until October 1, 1925, and under Permit No. 4792 until October 1, 1927. Since these time limits have expired and no further word has been heard from you, it is unknown whether the appropriations have ever been completed. Since the time limits expired so long ago, it is very important that you submit final proof of the appropriations immediately if you are interested in the perfection of these water rights. I am therefore enclosing forms for making final proof, which you should fill out and submit at your early convenience.

Section 47-506, Oregon Code 1950, provides that: "Whenever the time within which any appropriation under a permit should have been perfected shall have expired and the owner of such permit shall fail or refuse within the period of three months thereafter to submit to the State Engineer proof of the completion of such appropriation as required by Section 47-505, Oregon Code, the State Engineer may, after 60 days' notice by registered mail, order the cancellation of such permit, \* \* \* \*."

In accordance with the provisions of Section 47-506, Oregon Code 1950, a part of which is quoted above, you are hereby notified that unless we hear from you within sixty days from the date of this letter, your permit will be subject to cancellation without further notice.
