8. DESCRIPTION

Jacob's Reservoir is supplied by Rogue River Valley Irrigation District water during irrigation season. Irrigation district water is diverted from the Dean Owens Lateral to fill an existing small pond approximately 100 feet east of the Reservoir; water is then delivered via a buried pipe to a point near the south end of the reservoir as depicted on the enclosed site plan prepared by Matt Ropp Land Use Consulting, Inc.

Jacob's Reservoir is also supplied by two unnamed springs along the east bank as depicted on the enclosed site plan prepared by Matt Ropp Land Use Consulting, Inc.

Outflow is discharged via a pipe on the north end of the reservoir, into a ditch that ultimately discharges into Upton Slough to the north and west.

FEE STRUCTURE: The fee is based on the number of acre-feet proposed to be stored. The base fee is \$300. In addition, there is a fee of \$25 per acre-foot or fraction thereof. Example: 0.3 AF= \$325; 1.5 AF= \$350; 20.0 AF= \$800; 30.0 AF= \$1050. Plus a permit recording fee of \$400 (this fee is refunded if no permit is issued).

ORS 537,409 describes the criteria used to evaluate alternate reservoir applications.

The review shall be limited to issues pertaining to: a) water availability, b) potential detrimental impact to existing fishery resources; and c) potential injury to existing water rights. (ORS 537.409 (6))

Within 60 days after the department provides public notice...any person may submit detailed, legally obtained information in writing, requesting the department to deny the application for a permit on the basis that the reservoir: (a) Would result in injury to an existing water right; or (b) Would pose a significant detrimental impact to existing fishery resources. (ORS 537.409 (5))

The review of alternate reservoirs is limited to these criteria only.
