NOTICE OF BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION

I, Mrs. Ethel I. Blum, the holder of Application No. 9078, being
 Permit No. 5963, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon
(Reservoir or Entanglement)
 for the appropriation of 1 second-feet of the waters of Spring,
 in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer,
 began the actual construction of the works described therein on the 30th day of July, 1924,
 being within the time limitation as fixed in said permit for the beginning of construction work.

*Excavated 800 ft. of trail through brush in preparation for digging of ditch.
