RE: Eagle Valley Cancellations

Dear Myron:

During the final proof survey of permit No. 28626 the field engineers found that some people were using the wrong point of diversion. All of the transfers and the cancellations are a result of their findings.

The people who did not want to submit a transfer application were required to cancel the portion of their water right in question and apply for a new water right showing the correct point of diversion. The engineer's also found quite a number of acres being irrigated without the benefit of a water right. To take care of all of the land without water rights the Eagle Valley Irrigation District is preparing an application naming Eagle Creek as the primary source and Crater Lake Reservoir as supplemental. The people voluntarily abandoning their current water rights are to be a party to this new application.

We realize that there are many questions still un-answered, but we hope the result of our methods will be documentation of what is actually irrigated now and to make sure that the land has a water right with the correct point of diversion.

We used the original statement and proof of claims as well as researching the chain of ownership back to the time of the Decree when there was any question as to ownership or location within a quarter-quarter section.

I hope I have satisfactorily answered your questions.

During the final proof survey of the Crater Lake project you were contacted by representatives of the Oregon Water Resources Department. From the information you gave us and from what the engineers found on the ground during the actual survey it has been determined that your own property that is currently being irrigated by a ditch or ditches that are different than what is stipulated on your water rights.

To correct the water right records to show how you are actually irrigating your land and so that a certificate can be issued for the Crater Lake project it will be necessary for you to file an application for "Transfer in Point of Diversion" for your Eagle Creek water rights.

Since we have located a number of changes that have taken place since the original decree in 1918, the people in the Salem office have agreed to allow several people to file joint transfers. This would result in quite a savings over filing separate transfers.

A meeting has been set for Monday, February 12, 1980 at 1:00 p.m. at the Richland Grange Hall. Mr. Kent Searles, and I will meet with you at this time to explain the transfers. It is very important that you attend this meeting if you want to participate in filing jointly to save money.



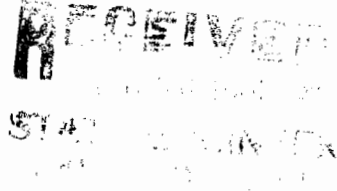



This will acknowledge your letter received March 3, 1963 regarding applications numbered R-34952 and 37065 filed in the name of Eagle Valley Irrigation Co., and advise your that M. Hanley has returned both applications to this office with the plans and specifications for construction of Crater Lake Reservoir.

The plans for the construction of the reservoir were approved by Mr. Wheeler on March 11, 1963. It is noted that there are some discrepancies between the plans and the applications. The plans provide for the storage of 190 acre feet of water, while the application is for 353 acre feet of water. The length, top width and free board of the dam do not agree with the information shown in the application and the same is true of the area to be submerged in the reservoir, the maximum depth and the mean or average depth. If you will authorize this office to correct application numbered R-34952 so that it is in agreement with the plans and specifications submitted, the application will be amended so that it will be in satisfactory form to be considered for approval by issuance of a permit with the next group.

Since application numbered 37065 provided for the appropriation of the water to be stored in the reservoir, it must also be amended so that the quantity of water to be appropriated is in agreement with the corrected reservoir application. It is noted that the 190 acre feet of water to be stored in the reservoir, if applied to the 8581 acres included in your tabulation of area to be irrigated, would provide only 0.022 acre foot of water for each acre. If the

total quantity of water was applied only to those lands included in the tabulation which do not now enjoy a right for their irrigation, 0.38 acre feet of water could be applied to each of the 505.16 acres. It may be that you will wish to reconsider the areas to which the water will be applied, limiting the area to the number of acres which the 190 acre feet of water could be most beneficially used.

I have made a rather detailed study of our records in relation to the water rights which are appurtenant to the lands described in the tabulation submitted with your application. In some cases it is very difficult to determine which rights are primary and which are supplemental. There is also a very decided lack of information regarding the exact location of some of the lands allowed a right by Circuit Court Decree. The Court's Decree did not in many cases follow the findings of the State Engineer in the adjudication proceedings. There is also the matter of some lands being submerged by back water from the Brownlee Dam. It is not clear whether these rights are to be transferred or abandoned.

Upon examination of the application map it is noted that the location of Eagle Creek and the lands to be irrigated in T.2 S., R.45 E., appear to have been shifted westward from their true location. This may have been caused by the scale of photographs used in preparing the map or lack of ground controls to properly position the photographs when preparing the map. We have indicated the information which is shown in our records regarding the location of the stream and the lands now enjoying a right for their irrigation. We are returning the tracing under separate cover, so that you might make the necessary corrections.

In view of the limited quantity of water available for appropriation under application numbered 37065 you decide to revise your tabulation of lands to be irrigated and wish to come to this office, we will make our records available for your examination and assist you in any way that we can. It does not appear that the source of water is adequate to include all of the lands listed in the tabulation and would not give adequate supply of water for a primary right on lands that do not now enjoy a right for their irrigation. We will withhold further action on the applications pending your reply.

This is with reference to the Crater Lake Dam rehabilitation plans which you have prepared for Eagle Valley Irrigation Company. I am returning these plans to you for more detail as outlined below:

1. We will need a cross section of the spillway together with a profile along the spillway center line and its hydraulic elements.
2. On the drawing labeled "Dam Cross Section" we will need to know the thickness of the polyethylene diaphragm together with any special provisions for back filling to prevent rupture of this diaphragm. Would you show us how this cross section will look after the log cribbing has been removed, the slopes graded and new material placed, and identify this material.
3. On the drawing labeled "Cross Section Through Conduit and Tunnel", would you indicate the diameter of the conduit, the invert elevation at the inlet and outlet, the type and gage of pipe to be utilized. Would you identify the valve by manufacturer and model number. Would you give some indication as to the dimensions of the trash rack and inlet structure. Would you further indicate how the upstream portion of the tunnel was sealed. Would you provide a location map and indicate the drainage area that would contribute to the runoff and indicate what the peak flood from this area would be, and provide area and capacity curves.
