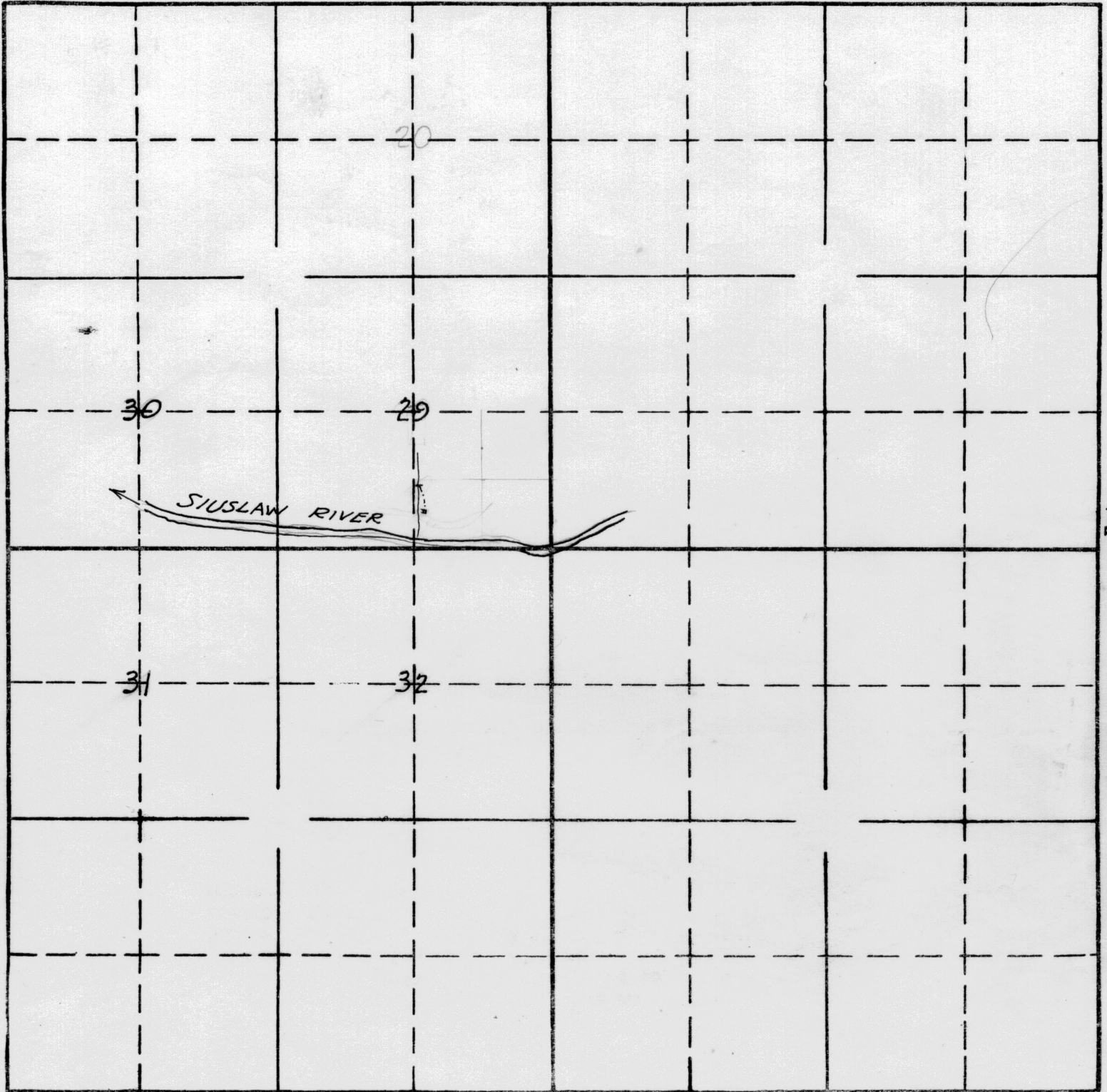

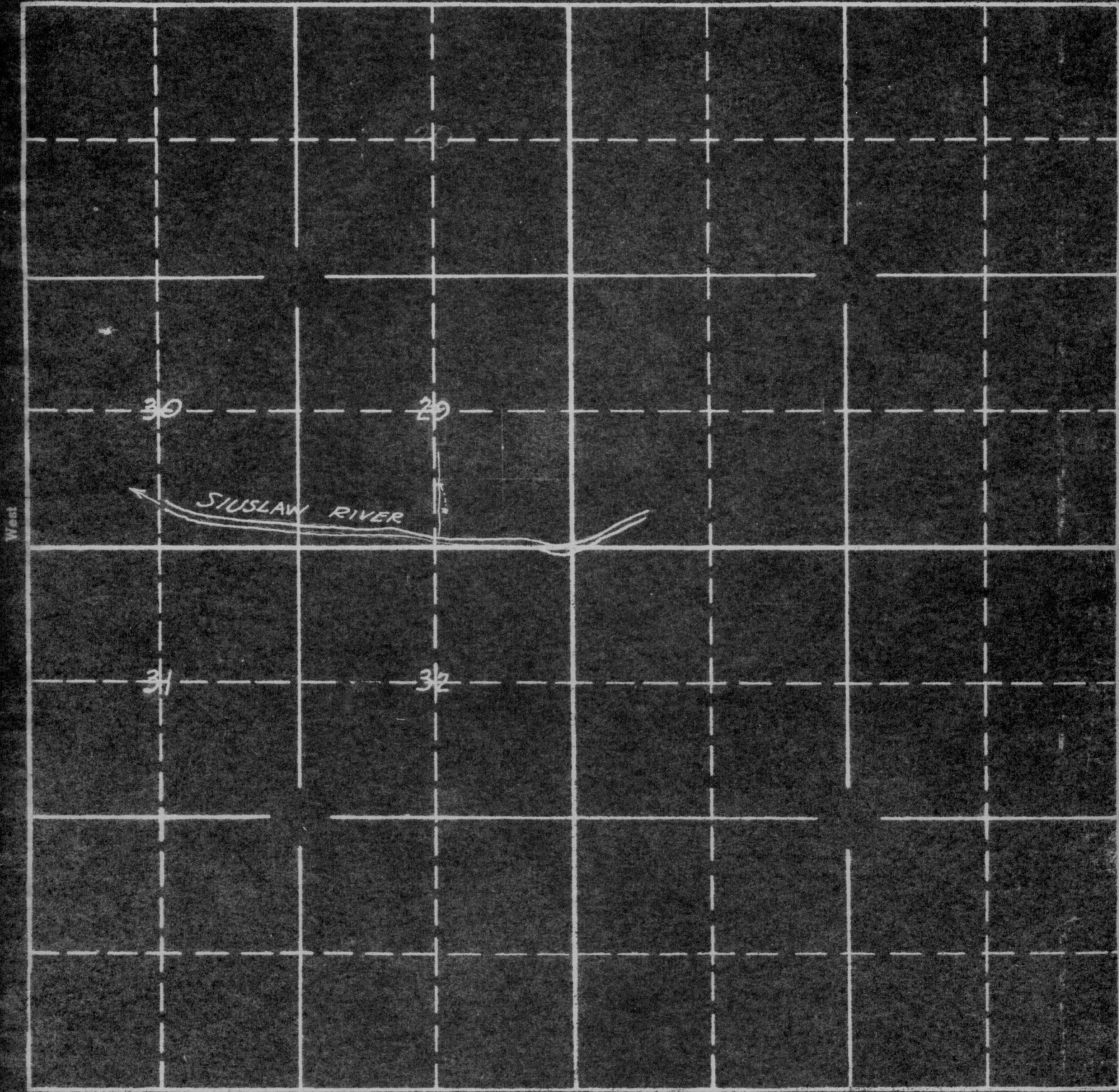



This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate water for irrigation and domestic use, together with fees in the amount of \$10, for which our Receipt No. 30670 is enclosed.

The application has been filed and given No. 20360. It has been checked over and found to be incomplete.

If the source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed stream, it should be so indicated under Item 1. If it is a spring, which is the point where water issues naturally from the earth, this should be shown under Item 1, the spring should be described on the enclosed form, and the written consent of the owner of the property on which the spring is situated, to the approval of your application, should accompany the application.

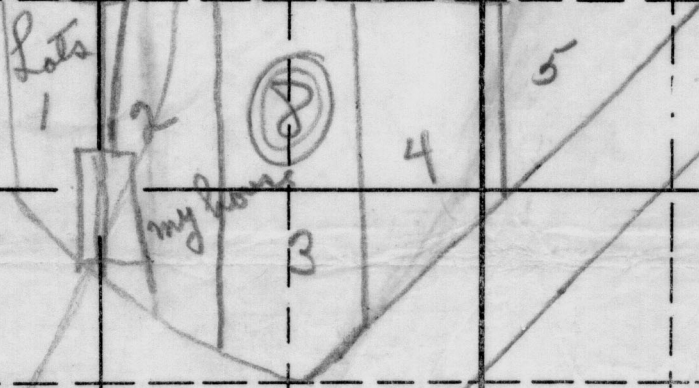
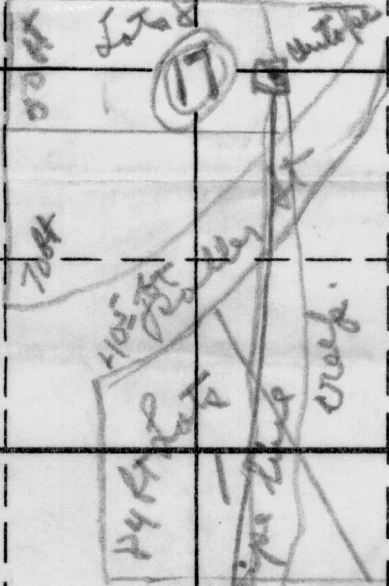
