

NOTICE OF COMPLETE APPLICATION OF WATER TO A BENEFICIAL USE

I, Mary L. Fulkerson, the holder of Application No. 7125, being Permit No. 5975, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for the appropriation of 4 1/2 second-feet of the waters of unrained stream in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, completely applied the water to a beneficial use, on the 10 day of December, 1923 being the time limitation as fixed in said permit or extended by the State Water Board for the complete application of water to a beneficial use.

Remarks: Water granted on permit is being used
If all of the water granted in this permit had not been fully applied to beneficial use, you should so state so that delinquent applications may have notice.

NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION

I, Mary L. Fulkerson, the holder of Application No. 7125, being Permit No. 5975, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for the appropriation of 4 1/2 second-feet of the waters of unrained stream in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, have completed the construction of the works described therein the 10 day of December, 1923, being within the time limitation as fixed in said permit or extended by the State Water Board for the completion of construction work.

Remarks: Water is used for domestic purpose and operating Hydraulic Ram and works has been started in order and has reached and can be immediately commenced.
If the works have a less capacity than as described in the permit, you have definitely abandoned your plan of retention and of the lands described in said permit, you should so state in order that you comply with the provisions of the act.

NOTICE OF BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION

I, Mary L. Fulkerson, the holder of Application No. 5975, being Permit No. 5975, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for the appropriation of 4 1/2 second-feet of the waters of stream, unofficially Clark Creek in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, began the actual construction of the works described therein on the 24 day of August, 1923, being within the time limitation as fixed in said permit for the beginning of construction work.

Clearing across brush preparatory to building dam. One man employed.
The applicant should state the nature of beginning construction work, number of men and water employed, the amount of work completed up to the date of this statement, and any additional information which may tend to show the beginning of work to good faith.
