The GENERAL FINDINGS OF FACT of the FINAL ORDER OF DETERMINATION is incorporated as if set forth fully herein.

# A. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On April 29, 1997, the UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE (USFS) timely submitted a Statement and Proof of Claim (Claim 485) to the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) pursuant to ORS Chapter 539 in the Klamath Basin Adjudication claiming a federal reserved water right under the Organic Administration Act of 1897, 16 U.S.C. §§ 473-478, 479-482 and 551 (Organic Act).
- 2. On August 3, 1999, the USFS timely amended Claim 485 as follows: (1) claimed water quantities were amended for the "[i]ntegration of water availability estimates provided by Oregon Water Resources Department pursuant to OAR 690-28-040(5)" and (2) "[f]urther analysis of fire records showed that numerous wildfires occur during the month of May, so the claim was amended to include that month."
- 3. The August 3, 1999 amendment to the original claim changed the period of use from June 1 through November 15 to May 1 through November 15, and increased the natural flow limits from 1.8 cfs to 2.4 cfs for Aug. 1 to Aug. 31, 1.2 cfs to 2.5 cfs for Sept. 1 to Sept. 30, 2.4 cfs to 2.9 cfs for Oct. 1 to Oct. 31, and 2.1 cfs to 3.2 cfs for Nov. 1 to Nov. 15. The amendment was a result of the exchange of correspondence between the Department and the Claimant concerning the Claimant's need to incorporate information concerning instream flow requirements. The Department intended to provide this information to the Claimant, but it was not available at the time of the claim filing deadline.
- 4. On September 30, 1999, Claim 485 was further amended to reflect a change in the place of use to include the headwaters of the main stem of Jackson Creek and all tributaries of the main stem located on non-reserved lands.

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- 5. The September 30, 1999 amendment changed the stream reach from JACKSON CREEK FROM SWNE, SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M., TO SENE, SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M. to "THE HEADWATERS OF THE MAIN STEM [Jackson Creek] AND ALL TRIBUTARIES OF THE MAIN STEM [..." This amendment expands the place of use by at least 10 river miles, and includes use from sources of water not identified in the original claim. The original claim described a reach from an upstream point to a downstream point. - 6. On October 4, 1999, following investigation of the evidence submitted, the Adjudicator issued a Summary and Preliminary Evaluation of Claims (Preliminary Evaluation) stating the claim was approved as amended on August 3, 1999.

- 12. On May 2, 2000, Robert Bartell timely filed Contest 1094 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 13. On May 2, 2000, Margaret Jacobs timely filed Contest 1329 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 14. On May 2, 2000, Carolyn Obenchain timely filed Contest 1563 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 15. On May 4, 2000, Rodney Z. James timely filed Contest 1912 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 16. On May 5, 2000, Newman Enterprise (Douglas Newman) timely filed Contest 2364 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 17. On May 5, 2000, Francis Loving Trust, Hilda Francis Trustee timely filed Contest 2601 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.

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- 18. On May 8, 2000, John Briggs timely filed Contest 4351 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 19. On May 8, 2000, Peter M. Bourdet timely filed Contest 4586 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 20. On May 8, 2000, Vincent Lee Briggs timely filed Contest 4819 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 21. On May 8, 2000, Thomas William Mallams timely filed Contest 5062 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 22. On May 8, 2000, Thomas H. Bentley timely filed Contest 5295 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 23. On May 8, 2000, Thomas E. Stephens timely filed Contest 5528 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 24. On May 8, 2000, Waterwatch of Oregon, Inc. timely filed Contest 2914 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 485.
- 25. These matters were referred to the Office of Administrative Hearings for a contested case hearing. The Office of Administrative Hearings designated these matters and other like claims of the USFS as Case 009.
- 26. On July 2, 2002, the following contestants withdrew with prejudice their respective contest: Leonard Baio, Gary Strong, Flynn Brothers, Robert Bartell, Margaret Jacobs, Carolyn Obenchain, Rodney Z. James, Newman Enterprise (Douglas Newman), Francis Loving Trust, Hilda Francis Trustee, John Briggs, Peter M. Bourdet, Vincent Lee Briggs, Thomas William Mallams, Thomas H. Bentley, Thomas E. Stephens, and David Cowan, successor in interest to William J. Rust and Ethel J. Rust. *See* NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF BAIO *ET AL'S* CONTESTS AGAINST THE UNITED STATES FOREST SERVICE CLAIMS (July 2, 2002).
- 27. On February 25, 2003, Waterwatch of Oregon, Inc. voluntarily withdrew Contest 2914. *See* WATERWATCH'S VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL OF CONTESTS (Feb. 25, 2003).
- On March 18, 2003, the OWRD and USFS executed STIPULATION TO RESOLVE CONTESTS 2162, 2163, 2166, 2168, 2169, 2171, 2172, 2174, 2177, 2184, 2186, 2188, 2190, 2192, 2194, 2196, 2198, 2200, 2201, 2203, 2205, 2207, 2209, 2211, 2213, 2214, 2216, 2218, 2220, 2222, 2224, 2225, 2227, 2229, 2231, 2233, 2234, 2236, 2238, 2240, 2242, 2244, 2246, 2248, 2250, 2252, AND 2253 (Settlement Agreement) which resolved the remaining contest (Contest 2172) to Claim 485.
- 29. On April 2, 2003, the Adjudicator withdrew Case 009 from the Office of Administrative Hearings.

The USFS's original claim and August 3, 1999 amendment of Claim 485 states that the beginning of the instream reach of Jackson Creek is located in the SWNE, SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M; however, the USFS claim map (Mylar filed as Claim # 377, Page 187) shows that the reach of this claim begins in the SESE, SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M; Therefore, OWRD finds that the beginning of the instream reach for this claim is the SESE, SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

### **B. DETERMINATION**

- 1. The Settlement Agreement executed between OWRD and USFS is adopted and incorporated as if set forth fully herein, with two exceptions:
  - a. that portion of the place of use that was expanded by the USFS's amendment of September 30, 1999; the place of use recognized herein is consistent with both the USFS's original claim and with it's August 3, 1999 amendment; and
  - b. the scrivener's error in the location of the beginning of the instream reach of Jackson Creek in the original claim and in the August 3, 1999 claim amendment as described in Finding 30, above, which was incorporated into in the Preliminary Evaluation; the location of the beginning of the instream reach is corrected to the SESE, Section 25.
- 2. The instream flows recognized pursuant to this claim are not additive to any other instream flows based on other water rights, permits or claims within the same stream reach or a portion of the same stream reach.
- 3. The GENERAL CONCLUSIONS OF LAW CONCERNING AMENDMENT OF CLAIMS is incorporated as if set forth fully herein.
- 4. The Department finds that the claim amendment described in Findings 2 and 3, above, does not constitute a new claim under ORS 539.210. This determination is based on the factors described in Findings 2 and 3, above. Because the amendment occurred prior to the beginning of open inspection, it is permissible and is incorporated into the Claimant's claim for consideration in this Findings of Fact and Partial Order of Determination.
- 5. OWRD finds that the claim amendment described in Findings 4 and 5, above, constitutes a new claim under ORS 539.210. The change in place of use is significant, including the addition of at least 10 additional river miles and the use of water from a source not originally claimed. There is no evidence on the record to suggest that the place of use for this claim was not reasonably ascertainable at the time of the claim filing deadline. As a result, this amendment may not be considered in the Findings of Fact and Partial Order of Determination for this claim.
- 6. The Organic Administration Act of 1897 for a federal reserved water right is a valid basis for this claim. The GENERAL CONCLUSIONS OF LAW CONCERNING CLAIMS BASED ON THE ORGANIC ADMINISTRATION ACT OF 1897 is incorporated as if set forth fully herein.

7. Based on the file and record herein, IT IS ORDERED that Claim 485 is approved as set forth in the following Water Right Claim Description.
