The GENERAL FINDINGS OF FACT of the FINAL ORDER OF DETERMINATION is incorporated as if set forth fully herein.

## A. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On April 30, 1997, the UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR, NATIONAL PARK SERVICE (USNPS) timely submitted a Statement and Proof of Claim (Claim 599) to the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) pursuant to ORS Chapter 539 in the Klamath Basin Adjudication claiming a federal reserved water right under the Act of May 22, 1902, ch. 820, §1, 32 Stat. 202; the Act of Aug. 25, 1916, ch. 408, §2, 39 Stat. 535 (National Park Service Organic Act); the Act of May 14, 1932, ch 184, 47 Stat. 155; the U.S. DISTRICT COURT OF OREGON, FINAL JUDGMENT NO. CIV-424 (C.C. Yawkey, et al., Dec. 5, 1940); the U.S. DISTRICT COURT OF OREGON, No. CIV-785, JUDGMENT ON THE DECLARATION OF TAKING AND AMENDED DECLARATION OF TAKING (Gladstone Land and Timber Co., Jan. 30, 1942); Pub. L. No. 96-553, 94 Stat. 3255 (Dec. 19, 1980); and Pub.L. No. 97-250, 96 Stat. 709 (Sept. 8, 1982).
- 2. On October 1, 1999, the USNPS timely amended Claim 599 to show the claimed priority date for each subdivision of a reach.
- 3. On October 4, 1999, following investigation of the evidence submitted, the Adjudicator issued a Summary and Preliminary Evaluation of Claims (Preliminary Evaluation) stating the claim was approved.
- 4. On May 5, 2000, the Claimant, USNPS, timely filed Contest 3943 to the Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 599.
- 5. On May 8, 2000, WaterWatch of Oregon, Inc. timely filed Contest 3013 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 599.

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- 6. On May 8, 2000, the following parties, hereinafter collectively referred to as "Nicholson et al.," filed Contest 3114 to the Claim and/or Preliminary Evaluation of Claim 599: Roger Nicholson; Roger Nicholson Cattle Co.¹; Lloyd Nicholson Trust²; Dorothy Nicholson Trust³; Richard Nicholson; Jim McAuliffe and McAuliffe Ranches⁴; Maxine Kizer; Ambrose McAuliffe; Susan McAuliffe; Joe McAuliffe Company⁵; Kenneth L. Tuttle and Karen L. Tuttle dba Double K Ranch; Dave Wood; Kenneth Zamzow; Anita Nicholson⁶; Wm. S. Nicholson; John B. Owens; Kenneth Owens; Wm L. Brewer; Mary Jane Danforth; Jane M. Barnes; Franklin Lockwood Barnes, Jr.; Jacob D. Wood⁶; Elmore E. Nicholson; Mary Ann Nicholson; Gerald H. Hawkins, Hawkins Cattle Co.; Owens & Hawkins; Harlowe Ranch; Terry M. Bengard; Tom Bengard; and Dwight T. Mebane and Helen Mebane<sup>8</sup>.
- 7. These matters were referred to the Office of Administrative Hearings for a contested case hearing. The Office of Administrative Hearings designated these matters and other like claims of the USNPS as Case 001.
- 8. On August 2, 2001, OWRD, the Claimants (USNPS) and the Contestants (WaterWatch, and Nicholson *et al.*) executed a STIPULATION (Settlement Agreement) which resolved the Contests 3013, 3114, and 3943 to Claim 599.
- 9. On August 2, 2001, the Claims 591-601 were withdrawn from the Office of Administrative Hearings pursuant to the Settlement Agreement.
- 10. As explained in the GENERAL CONCLUSIONS OF LAW CONCERNING FEDERAL RESERVED WATER RIGHTS the date of reservation is the priority date of a federal reserved water right. This claim has the following reservation dates: May, 22, 1902, based on the ACT OF MAY 22, 1902, CH. 820, §1, 32 STAT. 202 and December 5, 1940, based on U.S. DISTRICT COURT OF OREGON, FINAL JUDGMENT NO. CIV-424.

#### **B. DETERMINATION**

- 1. The Settlement Agreement executed between OWRD, the Claimants (USNPS) and the Contestants (WaterWatch, and Nicholson *et al.*) is adopted and incorporated as if set forth fully herein.
- 2. The instream flows recognized pursuant to this claim are not additive to any other instream flows based on other water rights, permits or claims within the same stream reach or a portion of the same stream reach.
- 3. The combination of the ACT OF MAY 22, 1902, CH. 820, §1, 32 STAT. 202; the ACT OF AUG. 25, 1916, CH. 408, §2, 39 STAT. 535; FINAL JUDGMENT No. CIV-424 (Dec. 5, 1940); and PUB. L. No. 97-250, 96 STAT. 709 (Sept. 8, 1982) are valid bases for this federal reserved water right claim, including the claimed purposes of use. The GENERAL CONCLUSIONS OF LAW CONCERNING FEDERAL RESERVED WATER RIGHTS are incorporated as if set forth fully herein.
- 4. Based on the file and record herein, IT IS ORDERED that Claim 599 is approved as set forth in the following Water Right Claim Description.
