that the amount of water for the purposes aforesaid, has been actually beneficially used in the amount of
0.36 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the as projected within Taylor SEC 19 19, T. 8 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-third of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
