

Certificate of Water Right Ownership Update

NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law, all water belongs to the public (ORS 537.110). In almost every instance, a permit or water right certificate from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting or storing water (ORS 537.130). However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A certificate of water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, the Department requests that this form be submitted to the Department. If for multiple rights, a separate form for each right will be required.

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J. JERROLD AND LOUANNE V. FERREE P.O. BOX 239 FLORENCE, OR 97439

confirms the right to use the waters of WOAHINK LAKE, a tributary of SILTCOOS LAKE, for HUMAN CONSUMPTION FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD AND HEAT PUMP OPERATION (NON-CONSUMPTIVE).

This right was perfected under Permit 52330. The date of priority is JULY 23, 1993. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.035 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND(CFS), BEING 0.005 CFS FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION ONLY FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD AND 0.03 CFS FOR HEAT PUMP USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 5 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.; NORTH 57 DEGREES 02 MINUTES WEST 1121 FEET FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 22.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurpanaWRD is as follows:

LOT 5 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4)

SECTION 22

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

SALEM, OR

A. The Director may require the water user to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the water user to install a meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.

The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain В. a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The water user shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening to prevent fish from entering the diversion. The required screen is to be in place, functional, and approved by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The return flow from the heat pump must be located at or near the point of diversion location.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.


The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds the use of water described by this right, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.
