

Certificate of Water Right Ownership Update

NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law, all water belongs to the public (ORS 537.110). In almost every instance, a permit **or** water right certificate from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting or storing water (ORS 537.130). However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A certificate of water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, the Department requests that this form be submitted to the Department. If for multiple rights, a separate form for each right will be required.

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.

NOTICE

Each certificate enclosed confirms the water right established under the terms of a permit or transfer order issued by this department. The water right is now appurtenant to the specific place where the use was established as described by the certificate. The owner of the land is the owner of the water right. Oregon law does not allow the Director to reissue a certificate because of a change in the ownership.

The water right is limited to a specific amount of water, but not more than can be beneficially used for the purposes stated within the certificate. The water must be controlled and not wasted. To change the location of the point of diversion, the character of use, or the location of use requires the advance approval of the Water Resources Director.

If any portion of this water right is not used for five or more consecutive years, that portion would be forfeited by the nonuse. However, land enrolled in a Federal Reserve Program is not subject to forfeiture during the period of enrollment. A water right may also be forfeited by any intentional act by the owner that would cause the water right to be unusable. For example, the land irrigated under the water right is made nonirrigable by covering it with pavement or buildings.



Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6853 submitted by

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 26421, was perfected under Permit 21054 with a date of priority of JANUARY 24, 1952. The right allows the use of a SIDE CHANNEL OF THE NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, a tributary of the NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 41.2 ACRES. STATUTORY WARRANTY DEED

Gray Properties, LLC, an Oregon limited liability company, Grantor, conveys and warrants to Western Rivers Conservancy, an Oregon nonprofit public benefit corporation, Grantee, the following described real property, free and clear of encumbrances except as specifically set forth below, situated in the County of Marion, State of Oregon:

PARCEL 1:

Government Lots 5, 6, and 7, and the South Half (S1/2) of the Southeast Quarter (SE1/4) of Section 16, Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM that parcel of land identified as a tract of land in Section 16, Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian which lies between the main channel and a secondary channel of the North Santiam River, and is part of the land conveyed to Dorsey B. and Aimee J.
