This Extension of Time request is being processed in accordance with Oregon Revised Statute 537.630 and 539.010(5), and Oregon Administrative Rule Chapter 690, Division 315

Application History

Permit G-12896 was issued by the Department on October 28, 1996. The permit called for completion of construction by October 1998, and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 1999. On March 11, 2013, King Estate Winery Inc. submitted to the Department an Application for Extension of Time for Permit G-12896. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on June 18, 2013, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction and to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2020. The protest period closed August 2, 2013, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

Findings of Fact

Except as expressly stated herein, The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the

findings of fact in the Proposed Final Order dated June 18, 2013.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, any comments received, and information within the file, the permit may be extended subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

1. Checkpoint Condition

The permit holder must submit a completed Progress Report Form to the Department by October 1, 2015. A form will be enclosed with your Final Order.

- (a) At each checkpoint, the permit holder shall submit and the Department shall review evidence of the permit holder's diligence towards completion of the project and compliance with terms and conditions of the permit and extension. If, after this review, the Department determines the permit holder has not been diligent in developing and perfecting the water use permit, or complied with all terms and conditions, the Department shall modify or further condition the permit or extension to ensure future compliance, or begin cancellation proceedings on the undeveloped portion of the permit pursuant to ORS 537.260 or 537.410, or require submission of a final proof survey pursuant to ORS 537.250;
- (b) The Department shall provide notice of receipt of progress reports in its weekly notice and shall allow a 30 day comment period for each report. The Department shall provide notice of its determination to anyone who submitted comments.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.630, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

Order

The extension of time for Application G-13645, Permit G-12896, therefore, is approved subject to conditions contained herein. The deadline for completing construction and applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from October 1, 2010 to October 1, 2020.
