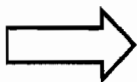

A 1 1/2" screened pickup pipe is anchored to rip rap in Condon Creek water is then pumped to a settling tank. From the settling tank a second pump distributes the water to two homes through particulate filters and finally through UV or chlorine treatment and distributed to each home through 1 1/2" PVC.

Sprinkler systems will be used to water domestic lawns and gardens.

This leaves surface water as the only potential water source for these two properties. We are seeking the surface water rights for these two homes to correct the previous incorrect assumption.

# Joint Water Use Agreement

The properties of 89060 Condon Creek Road Florence, Oregon 97439 (Map 17-11-28 tax lot 400) represented by Byron & Susan DeVries & 89050 Condon Creek Road Florence, Oregon 97439 (Map 17-11-28 tax lot 404) represented by Lois Leighton jointly wish to enter into an agreement to share a domestic water supply. Following describes the terms for which this agreement has been entered into.

**System Location-** The system is located on the Southeast area of 89060 Condon Creek Road Florence, Oregon 97439 and drafts water from approximately 50' upstream from this residence access bridge.

**System Description-** The system will divert water via pump with screened pickup from Condon Creek into a 1500 gallon settling/holding tank. The water will then be distributed to each home via a second pump which draws water from the holding tank. The water will be pumped from the tank through two pressure tanks, then through each homes independent filtration and purification systems. Following describes the equipment included in the system:

- ½ HP Grundfos draft pump
- ¾ HP Grundfos distribution pump
- 1500 gallon holding tank with float
- 2- pressure tanks
- 2- canister particulate filters per home
- Breaker panel

**System Use-** Each household is entitled to use the water for home/domestic use and domestic landscape, garden, lawn irrigation. Water shall not be used for agricultural irrigation.

**Maintenance Expenses-** Both parties agree to split 50/50 ongoing maintenance costs. Each home is responsible for costs associated with its respective filter and treatment systems. The current owners of 89060 Condon Creek Road Florence, Oregon 97439 agrees to perform the ongoing maintenance and service to the system in exchange for 89050 Condon Creek Road Florence, Oregon 97439 providing the utility power for the system.

**Equipment Repairs-** All equipment repairs and replacement shall be split 50/50 between both parties. The system shall be kept in fully operational order without significant deterioration.

**Utility Power for System-** 89050 Condon Creek Road Florence, Oregon 97439 shall pay for all utility costs to operate the system in exchange for 89060 Condon Creek Road Florence, Oregon 97439 supplying the facility location/structure and access for the system and performing the scheduled maintenance.
