Appeal Rights

This is a Final Order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This statement of judicial review rights does not create a right to judicial review of this order, if judicial review is otherwise precluded by law. Where no changes have been made to a Proposed Final Order on a water right application and no protests have been filed during the protest period, the Final Order is not subject to judicial review.

Application History

On December 4, 2012, Cameron Buck submitted an application to the Department for a water use permit. The Department issued a Proposed Final Order on June 4, 2013. The protest period closed July 19, 2013, and no protest was filed.

On September 19, 2013, the applicant amended the application by moving the location of Well 1. The applicant also submitted a revised map showing the new location.

On September 23, 2013, the Department reviewed the new location of Well 1 and determined that the February 15, 2013 public interest review will not change in any way.

The proposed use would not impair or be detrimental to the public interest, but the Department's continuing evaluation reveals that the Proposed Final Order requires modification to include the new location of Well 1. Application G-17602 therefore is approved with the above modifications to the Proposed Final Order, and Permit G-17077 is issued as limited by the conditions proposed by the Proposed Final Order.
