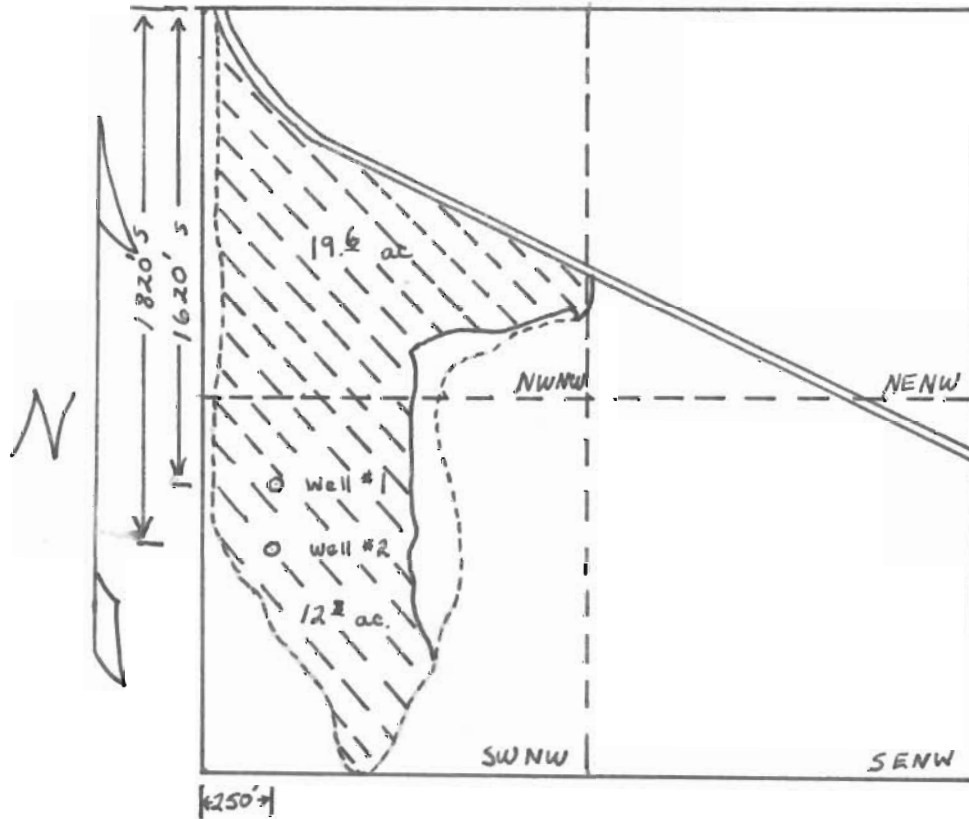

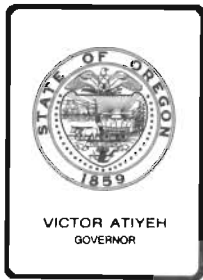
Supplementary Water Right

We have considered your application for extension of time to complete the construction and beneficial use phases under your permit number G-6178 and found we must deny it. Oregon revised statutes are very clear regarding extensions that the appropriater must show due diligence each year. Your extension application states that nothing has been done during the past year in which to develop the project. The letter granting permission for the extension a year ago informed you that you should make every effort to complete the project since it was doubtful that further extensions could be granted.

This decision does not however, preclude the new owner or yourselves for refileing for the same or similar project and utilizing the information in the present file for mapping and legal description.

Since this project was not completed within the terms it is invalid, and must be cancelled. I'm enclosing a cancel authorization form for you to clear this filing from the records.

The fees submitted with the extension cannot be refunded as it required by statute for submitting an application for extension to be considered. I'm enclosing forms for making a new filing in order for you or the purchaser to gain a valid water right permit for the use envisioned.

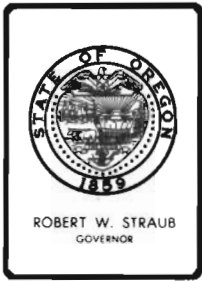

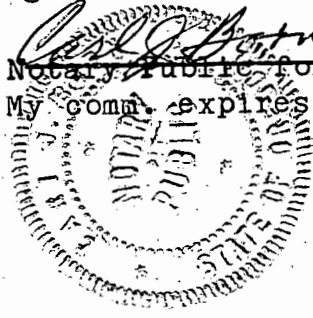

Erving Stankis was killed in an accident on September 23, 1978. As a result, nothing was done to complete the construction work on the irrigation system up to October 1, 1978.

Mr. Stankis willed all of his property to his wife, Elizabeth. Apparently she had no knowledge of the required completion dates of the irrigation system as she never mentioned anything about them to me. On July 10, 1979 Elizabeth passed away and the matter was not brought to my attention until I received your letter of October 31<sup>st</sup>.

I find that two wells have been drilled and that an adequate supply of water from those wells is assured. Pumps and power lines to complete the project have not yet been purchased or constructed at this time.

I would appreciate additional time to discuss this matter with the heirs of the Estate including time to complete the construction work on the project.

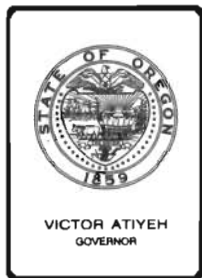

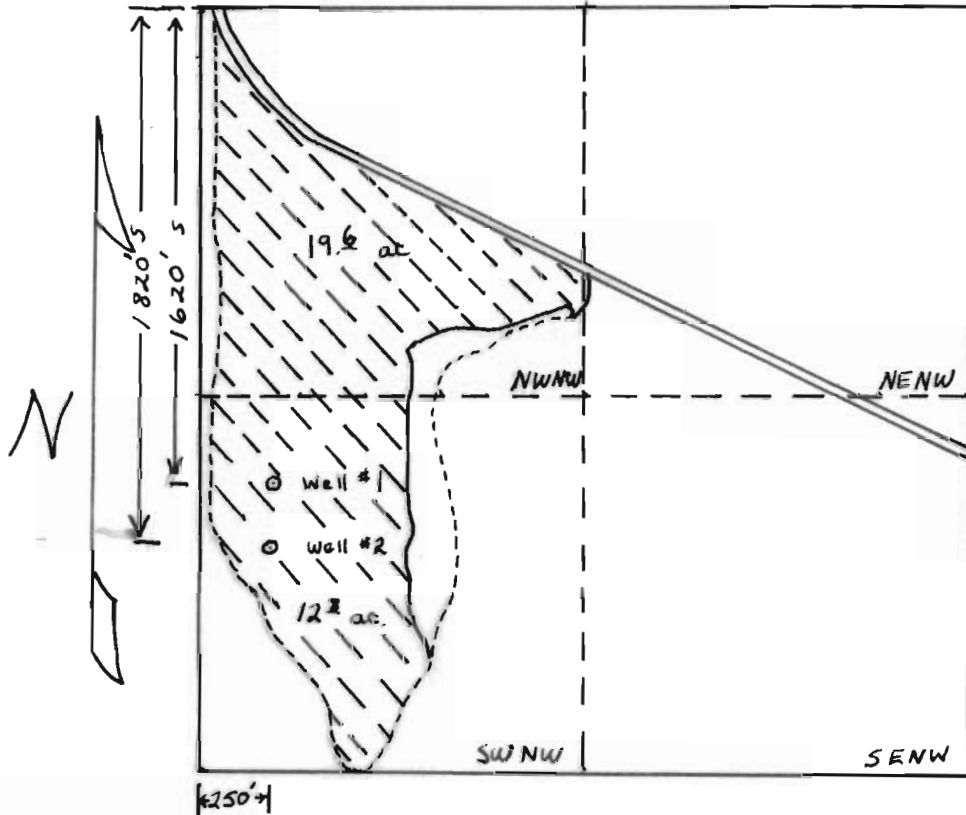

I redrew the map from an 8" - mile photo. I think the original map was also drawn from this photo, but was interpreted differently. The acreage in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  that this water will reach is 19.6 acres, although the original right covers more.

It seems we have another small problem. Concerning the abstract of permit number 25520, certificate number 27922, we seem to have a discrepancy between the points of diversion on the abstract and the point of diversion of the ditch (Luce-Long) that supplies the water. The abstract gives the point of diversion in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22, T. 13 S. R. 31 E. W.M. and the point of diversion of the Luce-Long ditch is in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22, T. 13 S., R. 31 E., W.M.

Which is correct? Should we leave both as is, or should a change be made on one or the other?

Now, we have a request or two. We're going to get the most we can out of this letter. Here goes!



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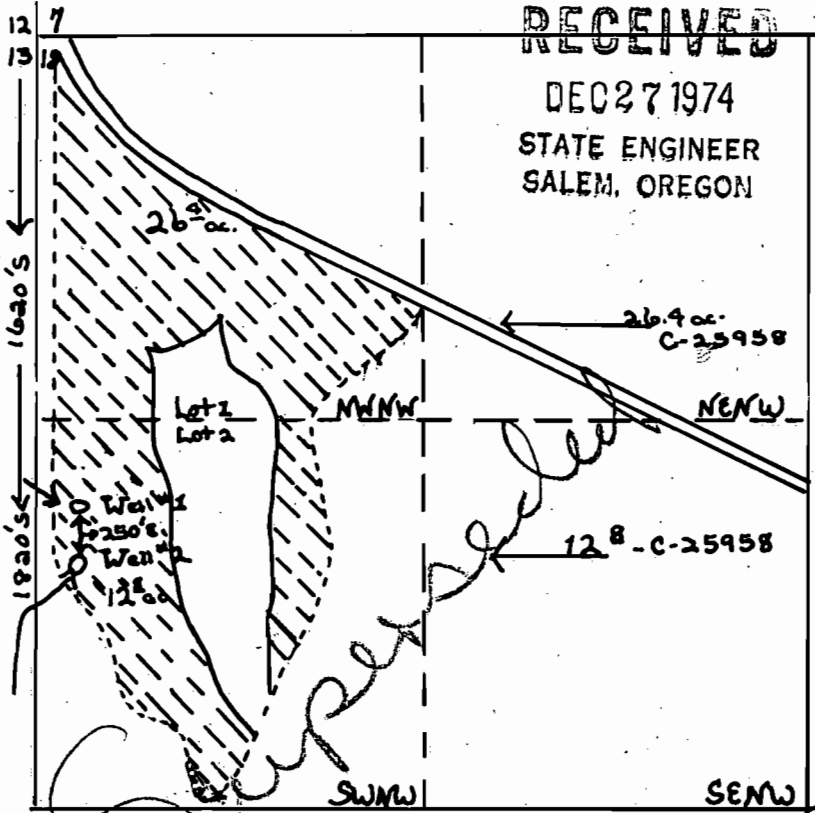
