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A. Diversion and Conveyance

Other means (describe): gravity feed into + out of tank. Outflow will go back into stream.

Provide a description of the proposed means of diversion, construction, and operation of the diversion works and conveyance of water. A metal box covers the current spring on lot 400. Two outflow pipes divide the water between the stream head + storage tank on lot 900. The storage tank overflows back into the stream. A  $\frac{1}{2}$ -1 horsepower pump will pump the water up the hill for lots 400, 1000, 1100 + 1102. Lot 400 will place an additional underground storage tank to be filled + gravity feed from the spring box. Lot 900's storage tank will be filled either with gravity feed or the pump.

B. Application Method

What equipment and method of application will be used? (e.g., drip, wheel line, high-pressure sprinkler) Normal faucets + shower heads.

C. Conservation

Describe: Mostly no aquatic life at stream head. Any that appear will be helped to a safer location until construction is complete.

Water quality will be protected by preventing erosion and run-off of waste or chemical products.

Describe: Plants will remain undisturbed as far as possible. No agriculture waste involved. Human waste will be confined to septic/drain fields + outhouses. No chemical products will be used.
