



On August 24, 1978, Frank M. Straus, acting for himself and as authorized agent for Harold Runstad, Betty Runstad, John P. Day, Jill Day, Ben Day, and Louise Day, submitted an affidavit that they are the legal owners of certain real property and the water rights appurtenant thereto, being for the storage of 480.0 acre feet of water from Rock Creek and the use of the stored water and not to exceed 1.01 cubic feet per second from the flow of Rock Creek, all with a priority date of January 12, 1956, for recreation and fish culture in the reservoir located within NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 35 South, Range 1 East, W.M., as described by the certificates recorded at pages 41767 and 41768, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Ira V. and Helen Ann Woolfolk;

That they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water rights and therefore authorize the Water Resources Director to cancel said water rights.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resource Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water rights, described by the certificates recorded at pages 41767 and 41768, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificares, are canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificates of water right are canceled.







Dear Mr. Straus:

Your water right transfer application for approval of a change in place of use and use heretofore made of water from Woolfolk Reservoir, together with supporting data and payment of fees in the amount of \$107.70, was received on April 28, 1978. Our receipt No. 2575 is enclosed.

If the supplemental rights described in the certificates recorded at pages 41767 and 41768, providing for the storage of water from Rock Creek in Woolfolk Reservoir and the use of water from Rock Creek, are not to be involved in the change in use of water, it will be necessary for you and the other owners of the property to authorize us to clear from our records that part of the supplemental rights not involved before your transfer application can be considered for approval. If the right to the use of water from Rock Creek has been forfeited due to nonuse for five successive years, it would be best to clear the entire supplemental right from our records at this time. We can prepare the necessary affidavits of abandonment for you and the other owners to complete.

We will prepare the notice of your proposed change for publication in the Main Tribune at Medford as requested.



Dear Dave:

I am enclosing prints of plans for the Woolfolk Dam. I would like for you to make an inspection of this works to determine the configuration of the various physical elements. The main point of contention is the emergency spillway. Mr. Baker of this office reports the spillway has a bottom width of 20 feet and a depth of 4 feet and has specified considerable erosion. The plans specify a bottom width of 40 feet at the control and a depth of 5 feet below the top of the dam. Mr. Baker further reports the top width of the dam at 18 feet. The plans call for a 20-foot top width. Eighteen feet would be satisfactory for this height dam provided the dam was constructed with this 18-foot crest width and not with a 20-foot crest width which has sloughed or eroded to 18 feet.

While you are there, see if you can determine whether or not the reservoir was full when this last storm hit and if so, what was the depth of the flow in the spillway.


Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of your notice to the effect that complete application of water has been made under Permit No. 24023.

Pursuant to your report and in line with the general practice of this office a survey will be made at a later date. After this survey, proof may be made and certificate issued covering the actual use of water as found by the engineer. In case of irrigation, any lands described in the permit that have not been irrigated will be automatically eliminated from the water right.

In the meantime, the permit which you hold will be valid evidence of the water right in question so long as you continue to use the water.

Dear Dave:

I am enclosing prints of plans for the Woolfolk Dam. I would like for you to make an inspection of this works to determine the configuration of the various physical elements. The main point of contention is the emergency spillway. Mr. Baker of this office reports the spillway has a bottom width of 20 feet and a depth of 4 feet and has specified considerable erosion. The plans specify a bottom width of 40 feet at the control and a depth of 5 feet below the top of the dam. Mr. Baker further reports the top width of the dam at 18 feet. The plans call for a 20-foot top width. Eighteen feet would be satisfactory for this height dam provided the dam was constructed with this 18-foot crest width and not with a 20-foot crest width which has sloughed or eroded to 18 feet.

While you are there, see if you can determine whether or not the reservoir was full when this last storm hit and if so, what was the depth of the flow in the spillway.
