under Permit No. G-1637 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 8, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

### 0.48 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (SW2 NM2), Section 28, T. 6 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Well located 42 chains North, and 12 chains East from SW corner, Sec. 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sightisth of one cubic foct per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,
