In the attached letter our consultant Nancy Rorick (RG, CWRE) describes the issues associated with two permits: G12625 and G16009. In both cases the Department mistakenly issued supplemental water rights when the applicant had applied for primary water rights. After consulting with the Department, we are submitting a groundwater permit application. The purpose of submitting the application is to correct the Department's errors by applying for groundwater rights so that the lands that currently have only supplemental water rights will also have primary water rights.

We are requesting that the Department waive the fee for this permit application because the Department erred by issuing supplemental water rights when we had applied for primary water rights. We don't believe that it is fair for the Department to collect fees to process a new application that wouldn't be required if the Department had correctly processed the original applications.

This letter provides background information that you requested on the issues associated with John and Kate Rohner's water rights. I was asked by the Rohners to prepare a COBU for permit G16009. While researching the project, I discovered three issues with the Rohners' water rights.

Issue 1

The lands in SE¼ NE¼, Section 11, T9S, R39E have supplemental water rights that are not covered with primary water rights. The water rights in the portion of the ¼ ¼ north of Pocahontas road area are listed below (maps attached).

- Certificate 7914 (priority July 1, 1924) 20 acres of supplemental water right from an unnamed spring.
- Permit G12625 (priority March 20, 1995) 20.5 acres of supplemental water right and 5.5 acres of primary water right from a sump.
- Permit G16009 (priority April 13, 2006) 25.5 acres of supplemental water right from a well.

The original application for permit G12625 (attached) shows that the applicant requested 26 acres of primary water right in the SE½ NE½ of section 11. However, permit G12625 was issued for 5.5 acres of primary and 20.5 acres of supplemental water right. The supplemental and primary acreages were also switched in the plat card report¹. This is probably why Permit G16009 was issued for 25.5 acres of supplemental water right in the SE½ NE½ of section 11.

Issue 2

In the NE% NE% of section 11 permit G16009 was issued for 40 acres of supplemental water right, but there are only 38 acres of primary water right in the ½ ½. The water rights in the ½ ½ are listed below.

• Certificate 4161 (priority 1875) – 37.5 acres of primary water right from Washington Gulch.

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¹ The plat card report showed 5.5 acres of supplemental water right and 20.5 acres of primary water right. Gerry Clark reported in an email dated 1/23/2014 that the plat card report has been corrected.

- Permit G 12625 (priority March 20, 1995) 0.5 acres of primary water right and 39.5 acres of supplemental water right from a sump.
- Permit G16009 (priority April 13, 2006) 40 acres of supplemental water right from a well.

The permit map for G16009 that I downloaded from Water Rights Information System (WRIS) shows that 38 acres of supplemental water rights in the ¼ ¼ and 2 acres of primary water right. These were crossed out and change to 40 acres of supplemental water rights (map attached). I don't know who made this change.

Issue 3

The final proof map (attached) that I downloaded from WRIS for permit G12625 has two acreage errors.

- The map shows only 11 acres of supplemental water right in the SE¼ NE¼ of Section 11 north of Pocahontas road. The Rohner's irrigate the entire ¼ ¼ north of Pocahontas Road an area of about 27 acres.
- The map shows 14 acres of primary water right on the north side of Pocahontas Road in the SW ¼ NE ¼ of section 11. This is too much; the final proof map should show about 10 acres in this area.

Corrective Action

I've discussed how to remedy these water right issues with Rick Lusk (Water Master) and Gerry Clark in Salem. We've developed the following series of steps.

1. The Rohners will submit an application for a primary water right using water from their well for 27.3 acres in the SE½ NE½ and 2 acres in the NE ½ NE ½ of section 11

They will wait for the permit to be issued before completing the next two steps.

- 1. The Rohners will submit the COBU for G16009 which will not prove up on the area permitted under the new permit.
- 2. The Rohners will submit a COBU for G12625 that will supersede the one on file with the Department. This will correct the mistakes contained in the original one.


