#### Appeal Rights

**This is a final order in other than a contested case.** This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. A request for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either file for judicial review, or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

#### Application History

Permit S-51684 was issued by the Department on August 29, 1995. The permit called for actual construction was to begin by August 29, 1996, completion of construction by October 1, 1997 and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 1998. On October 14, 2014,

ACMPC Oregon 2, LLC (dba Halls Ferry Farms) submitted to the Department an Application for Extension of Time for Permit S-51684. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on December 2, 2014, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction from October 1, 2004 to October 30, 2019 and the time to apply water to full beneficial use from October 1, 2004 to October 30, 2019. The protest period closed January 16, 2015, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings in the Proposed Final Order dated December 2, 2014.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, the permit may be extended subject to no additional conditions.


### **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

### **ORDER**

The extension of time for Application S-71058, Permit S-51684, therefore, is approved. The deadline for completing construction is extended from October 1, 2004 to October 30, 2019. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from October 1, 2004 to October 30, 2019.
