

## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

FRED REICHOW ROUTE 1, BOX 33 MILTON-FREEWATER, OREGON 97862

to use the waters of ONE WELL in the GOODMAN SPRING BRANCH BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 78.54 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application G-12053. The date of priority is MARCH 23, 1990 FOR 0.5 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) AND AUGUST 9, 1991 FOR 0.26 CFS. The use is limited to not more than 0.76 CFS, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well. The use of water is limited to the period of April 1 through June of each year.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 29, T 6 N, R 35 E, W.M.; 20 FEET NORTH AND 600 FEET EAST FROM NE CORNER OF THE S 1/2, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This permit shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior permit for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 40.54 ACRES
SECTION 29
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 38.00 ACRES
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevations in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1993, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1994. Complete application of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 1995.



# Certificate of Water Right Ownership Update

#### NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law, all water belongs to the public (ORS 537.110). In almost every instance, a permit or water right certificate from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting or storing water (ORS 537.130). However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A certificate of water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, the Department requests that this form be submitted to the Department. If for multiple rights, a separate form for each right will be required.

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.
