

Certificate of Water Right Ownership Update

NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law, all water belongs to the public (ORS 537.110). In almost every instance, a permit or water right certificate from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting or storing water (ORS 537.130). However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A certificate of water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, the Department requests that this form be submitted to the Department. If for multiple rights, a separate form for each right will be required.

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PAUL G. AND AL VERTA J WILLIAMSON PO BOX 134 (48084 CONLEY) VIDA OR 97488

confirms the right to use the waters of COUGAR AND BLUE RIVER RESERVOIRS, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-5363, TRIBUTARIES OF MCKENZIE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 0.241 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 51537. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 4, 1991. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.603 ACRE FOOT or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The period of allowed use is April 1 through September 30.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

A. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month, and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

Further, the Director may require the water user to report general water-use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the right.

B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The use of water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of Water Service Contract 2-07-10-W0887, dated May, 1992, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the water user, or a satisfactory replacement. A copy of the contract is in Application File #71821 at the Water Resources Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening and by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
