1) Is there a connection to a 303(d) listed water quality limited water body? \(\subseteq \text{NO} \text{ NO} \text{ XES} Explain: The North Umpqua River is 303(d) listed for temperature and dissolved oxygen impairments (spawning season; September 1-June 15); TMDLs have been issued for impairments during the non-spawning period. Flow & temperatures in the mainstern are affected in part by hydropower operations. The natural thermal potential temperature exceeds the numeric criterion (16oC) so there is no assimilative capacity for the North Umpqua River below Steamboat Creek. Besides the human use allowance, all sources are allocated zero heat loads above background. ☐ MEDIUM □ LOW 2) What is the potential for this use to impact a water quality limited water body: \(\subseteq \text{HIGH} \) Explain: Thermal impacts assessment by DEQ indicates that a 0.02 cfs withdrawal on the North Umpqua river (for year-round domestic use expanded for three households) at existing flow volumes would not produce measurable negative thermal impacts.
