

This will acknowledge your maps, fees of \$75.90, and application for a permit to appropriate 0.85 cubic foot per second of water from Boonsville Channel of the Willamette River for the irrigation of 68.0 acres and application for a permit to appropriate 0.56 cubic foot per second of water from a well for the irrigation of 45.0 acres. Your applications have been filed as No. 54549 and G-7442, respectively.

A legal description of the property upon which the water will be used must accompany both applications. This can be copied from your deed, title insurance policy or sales contract.
