Hi Steve, cert 80535 has the rate more than an $1 / 80$ per irrigated acre from groundwater. Total acres under the cert is 338.8 acres $/ 80=4.235 \mathrm{CFS}$. The cert gives 4.28 CFS . The cert has 238.2 acres of primary which would be at $1 / 80=2.98$ CFS. Well $\# 2$ must of been deficient in production as the supplemental portion for 100.6 acres the rate is 0.75 . Mr. Blaylock is in the process of doing an additional POA transfer as \# 2 does not produce well. Could the rate from well \# 2 be a full $1 / 80$ th under this right? if not I guess he should file another application to make up the rate from well \# 2.

Cert 80533 has a typo error on the legal, the SW 1/4 SW $1 / 4 \quad 0.4$ acres should be in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4.

Both these certs are in the name of Leo Barclay and have not been filed in the vault yet,( as of a few minutes ago anyway) through the web page on the internet.
I thought about sending you copies through the us mail, but hopefully you can get someone to retrieve them for you instead of me putting postage on something to send to you that is already in the building you work in.

Cert 80533 is a remaining right superseding cert 36755 and a comfirming right for T3771.

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 2 in the FIELDS BASIN for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATING 37.6 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under permit G-7983. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 8, 1977. The right is limited to not more than 0.47 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:
