Dear John:

There seems to be some confusion regarding the map showing the location for the place of use, point of diversion, etcetera; under Permit numbered 9747. In order to complete your records, I am enclosing a print of the map which accompanies Permit numbered 9236 and have indicated on the map that the place of use under Permit 9747 is an extension of the pipeline to a schoolhouse from the residence of Charles A. Stelzier.

The history on this is that School District Number 57 at Myrtle Creek used water from an unnamed tributary of South Myrtle Creek for domestic purposes by carrying the water to the schoolhouse in a bucket. About 1929, it was decided to pipe the water to the schoolhouse, and this was done with cooperation of a Mr. Charles A. Stelzier whose property the pipeline crossed. On February 9, 1929, Mr. Stelzier filed an application for permit to cover his appropriation for his household domestic use. On July 5, 1930, School District Number 57 filed an application for permit to cover their use of water from the unnamed tributary for domestic purposes. There was some confusion over this as the two parties originally intended to file jointly under one application. For some reason, this office accepted the school district's application with a copy of Mr. Stelzier's application map and issued a permit. The only information we have as to the exact location of use under Permit numbered 9747 is that the water was piped to a schoolhouse by extending the pipeline used by Mr. Stelzier under Permit numbered 9236.

I hope that this supplies you with sufficient information as to use and completes your map file.
