PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a well

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/60th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be cased as necessary in accordance with good practice and if the flow is artesian the works shall include proper capping and control valve to prevent the waste of ground water.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The priority date of this permit is March 9, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 21, 1978 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1979

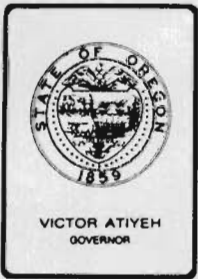

On May 7, 1985, a representative of this office made an inspection of land in connection with your Permit G-7305. This permit allowed for the use of up to 0.50 cubic foot per second of water from a well for the irrigation of 40.0 acres.

Our representative talked with Mrs. Weedman, who explained that the well has been adequate only for domestic purposes. Domestic use and irrigation of up to 1/2 acre of non-commercial lawn and garden from a well is a use exempt from the requirement of a permit under Oregon law. If this information is correct, the permit serves no purpose and should be cancelled.

The form handed to Mrs. Weedman by our representative is for your use in authorizing the cancellation of this permit. The cancellation would clear it from our records and avoid the necessity for further notices or correspondence.
