In a review of the records of water rights in Douglas County it was discovered that the area covered by the terms of your permit No. 27594, which was issued to you on December 4, 1961 in approval of your application No. 37024 , duplicates in part the area covered by the water right evidenced by the certificate recorded at page 5313, State Reoord of yater Rights Certificates.

This apparent duplication of water rights should have been discovered and corrected at the time your applicstion vas considered for approval, but through an oversight on our part it vas not.

It is my understanding that for many years prior to the time you filed application No. 37024 that the land in question had not been irrigated under the provisions of the old water right evidenced by the certificate.

Jnder the provisions of 023540.510 , if a completed and perfected water right as evidenced by the certificate is not used for a period of five or more years of continuous nonuse the right to use water ceases and the water right becomes subject to cancelation by an order of the State aggineer.

To clear such an unused fight fros the records, one of two procedures can be employed: one, the owners of the property to which the water fight is appurtenant can sign and submit an affidavit abandoning interest in the vater right and requesting it to be canceled; in which case an order can be entered by the State Bagineer imediately.

The second procedure is for the State Engineer to send notice to the omers of the property, allowing them 60 days in which to object, to the proposed cancelation and if objections are filed, bring the matter to a hearing before the State Engineer. Based upon evidence presented at the hearing, the State engineer would then enter an order either canceling the right or dismissing the proceedings.
