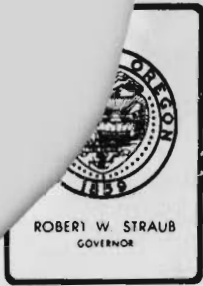

Gentlemen,

On July 29, 1977, a representative of this office inspected the property in connection with the incomplete water right represented by your permit numbered G-6504. This permit describes the appropriation of 0.01 cubic foot of water per second from Well No. 3 for the irrigation of 26.2 acres.

The report submitted by our field engineer shows water has been used from the well only for domestic supplies and an office and buildings. He also reported that Well No. 3 is not tied into your irrigation system. If you do not intend to use water from the well for irrigation purposes, the permit should be canceled.

I have enclosed a partially completed form for your use in authorizing the cancellation of the permit. Your authorization to cancel the permit would allow us to clear it from our records and avoid the necessity for further notices or correspondence.

Dear Sirs:

We have recently received your applications numbered G-7000 through G-7005 as well as the reproducible maps and property descriptions. Thank you for your check in the amount of \$60.75 for the additional irrigation recording fees.

I talked with Mr. H.Q. Walton, Jr. on the telephone the other day and it was my understanding that Weyerhaeuser Co. is willing to cancel the surface water rights mentioned in my previous correspondence. I have prepared the affidavits of abandonment. Please examine the statements and if they are correct, have them notarized and returned to our agency at your earliest convenience.

The property descriptions submitted do not cover all of the lands described under certificate 20545, therefore, the affidavit describes only a portion of the certificate. We will have to issue a new certificate covering the lands not involved in the cancellation and for this we will need a certificate recording fee of \$2.00.

My request for additional irrigation fees was not accurate. Application No. G-7000 describes the irrigation of 34.6 acres and the recording fee should be \$11.25. Application G-7001 includes 40.4 acres which requires an irrigation recording fee of \$12.75, and application G-7003 needs a recording fee of \$12.00 for the 37.2 acres described. I requested only a \$10.00 fee for each application and I apologize for this oversight. We will need an additional \$6.00 to complete the fees.

Dear Sir:

Your application for a permit to appropriate 194 gallons of water per minute from Well No. 1 for the irrigation of 34.6 acres has been received along with an application for a permit to appropriate 226.6 gallons of water per minute from Well No. 2 for the irrigation of 40.4 acres, an application for a permit to appropriate 4.49 gallons of water per minute from Well No. 3 for the supplemental irrigation of 26.2 acres, an application for a permit to appropriate 209.8 gallons of water per minute from Well No. 4 for the irrigation of 37.4 acres, an application for a permit to appropriate 118 gallons of water per minute from Well No. 5 for the irrigation of 21 acres, and an application for a permit to appropriate 193 gallons of water per minute from Well No. 7 for the irrigation of 32.5 acres. We have also received a reproducible map for each application and the fees of \$90.00. The applications have been filed as numbers G-7000 through G-7005 respectively.

Although you have indicated that the wells will supplement Permit numbered 21132, you have also indicated that water from the wells will be the primary source of supply. If you do not intend to appropriate water from the Pudding River as allowed under certificate 22524 (Permit 21132) as the primary source of supply, it will be necessary for you to submit an affidavit of abandonment canceling the water right. On the other hand, if the river water will be used, your application will have to be amended to show supplemental irrigation only.

In the event the right is to be canceled, it will be necessary for you to delete the information given in item 12 of the application. Application numbered G-7002 can be amended to show supplemental irrigation from the 4 wells; therefore, the data given in item 18 of Application No. G-7000 should be deleted and only referenced to primary irrigation retained in the remarks section of the application. Similar problems exist with your applications numbered G-7001 and G-7003, if the earlier right is to be canceled, the information given in items 12 and 18 will have to be deleted and the remarks section amended to show only the primary irrigation project.

As pointed out earlier, application G-7002 can be amended by listing supplemental irrigation in item 3 and describing the location of the 4 wells in item 4. A specific quantity of water to be appropriated from each well will also have to be listed on the application as well as completing items 6, 8 and 10 by including the 4 wells. This information can be given under the remarks section or on a separate sheet of paper.

If certificate 22524 is canceled, our records show that only 24.2 acres will be remaining within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, Township 4 South, Range 1 East, W.M. and this does not agree with the acreage figures given in item 12 of your application. If 26.2 acres are to be irrigated within the N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , it will be necessary to change G-7002 to show the 24.2 acres as supplemental irrigation and 2 acres as primary irrigation. The primary irrigation probably should be labeled as being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of this section as shown on your map since this was not included under certificate 32625.

There is a typing omission in item 18 of your application number G-7004. The permit should be numbered G-1811.

Each map to support the applications must show the township designation. Also, the description of the location of the wells must be shown on each map to agree with the information given in item 4 of each application. The number of acres to be irrigated will also have to be shown in each forty acre tract on the map to correspond with the data given in item 12 of each application.

An irrigation recording fee of \$10.00 is also required for each application, with the exception of G-7005 which requires a fee of \$10.75.

A copy of the legal description of the property upon which the water will be used must also accompany the applications. This can be copied from your deed, sales contract, or title insurance policy.

I am returning the six applications and supporting maps for correction and completion. The applications are endorsed so that in order to retain their priority dates, they must be received in this office on or before September 24, 1975.
