NOTE: A completed water availability statement from the local watermaster, Land Use Information Form completed by the local Planning Department, fees and site map meeting the requirements of OAR 690-340-030 must accompany this request. Failure to provide any of the required information will result in return of your application. The license, if granted, will not be issued or replaced by a new license for a period of more than five consecutive years. The license, if granted, will be subordinate to all other authorized uses that rely upon the same source, or water affected by the source, and may be revoked at any time it is determined the use causes injury to any other water right or minimum perennial streamflow.

If water source is a well, well logs or adequate information for the Department to determine aquifer, well depth, well seal and open interval, etc. are required. The licensee shall indicate the intended aquifer. If for multiple wells, each map location shall be clearly tied to a well log.

If a limited license is approved, the licensee shall give notice to the Department (Watermaster) at least 15 days in advance of using the water under the Limited License and shall maintain a record of use. The record of use shall include, but need not be limited to, an estimate of the amount of water used, the period of use and the categories of beneficial use to which the water is applied. During the period of the Limited License, the record of use shall be available for review by the Department upon request.

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Attachment #1 (Section #3 Well Development)

I bought this property in June of 2004. At that time I did not receive any information for a well log from the previous owner who's family had been in possession of the property for many generations, nor did the title company have this information. I researched all of the closing/title records from my purchase packet, notes from the seller, county and state water resource records and local well drillers and have not been able to locate a well log for this well. Just recently I applied for and received a well ID number. Please see the attached letter from Ladeena Bell at The Water Resource Department. Ladeena says there is "no known well log for this well'. The well information I was able to attain is from a well test done on October 24, 2014 by Star Water Systems in Lebanon. A copy of the job invoice is attached. Static water level, well depth, pump set height, casing size and drop pipe information was all noted by Star Water Systems.


Attachment #2 (Section #5 Water Management, C. Conservation)

The water I am requesting is needed to establish and maintain a viable hazelnut orchard. Using drip as the irrigation type will eliminate water waste. I intend to start out by putting individual emitters at each tree, which will greatly decrease the water need during the first few years of establishment. As the trees grow, emitters will be added to water the ever expanding root zone. Soil moisture will be observed on a daily basis to monitor for over or under-watering.

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
