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# Certificate of Water Right Ownership Update

#### NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law, all water belongs to the public (ORS 537.110). In almost every instance, a permit or water right certificate from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting or storing water (ORS 537.130). However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A certificate of water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, the Department requests that this form be submitted to the Department. If for multiple rights, a separate form for each right will be required.

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.

#### CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That the HURRICANE CREEK IRRIGATING DITCH COMPANY, a corporation, by S. P. Crow, Secretary, of Lostine, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Hurricane Creek, a tributary of the Wallowa River, for the purpose of the irrigation of 1,283 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and the development of 2 horsepower, and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER ROARD of Oregon. in Volume 5, pages 174 and 175; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1885; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes; and shall not exceed 12 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season for irrigation, domestic and stock and 2.2 cubic feet per second for power; and said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said docree.

A description of the land irrigated under such rights, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
