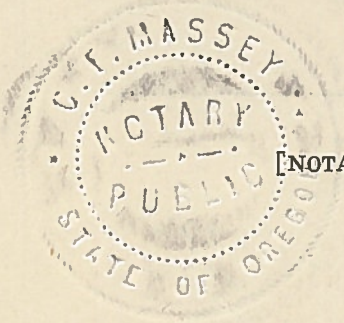

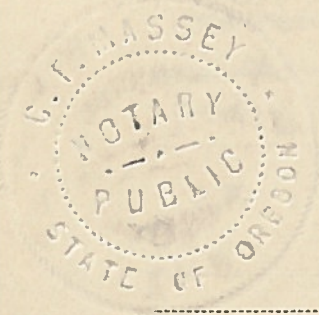

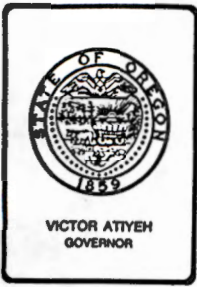

On August 22, 1980, the Water Resources Director of Oregon issued an order authorizing cancellation of a portion of a water right for the use of 0.10 cubic foot of water from waste water and slough water, with a date of priority of October 9, 1925, for supplemental irrigation of a certain 0.8 acre in SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 8 South, Range 46 East, WM.

The amount of water to be canceled was incorrectly stated as being 0.10 cubic foot per second. The correct amount of water for irrigation of 0.8 acre, at the rate of 0.0125 cubic foot per second per acre, is 0.01 cubic foot per second.



I would like to request a new certificate of water rights for two reasons concerning permit #6976 cert. # c - 49634 on my Clear Creek supplemental right.

The current certificate does not clearly show the source of water. The original application under the remarks section (F.S. Morrison) clearly shows the intended source and this description should be on the revised certificate.

Also, there was a mistake made on the amount of water. The original right showed .5 cubic feet and the revised certificate only shows .273 cu. ft. . I believe this is an error. Reducing the right from 40 acres to 29 acres as was agreed should not have reduced the amount of water from .5 to .273. Your attention to this matter is greatly appreciated.



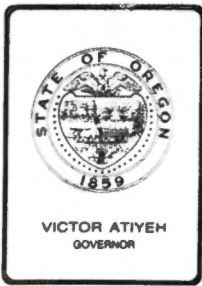

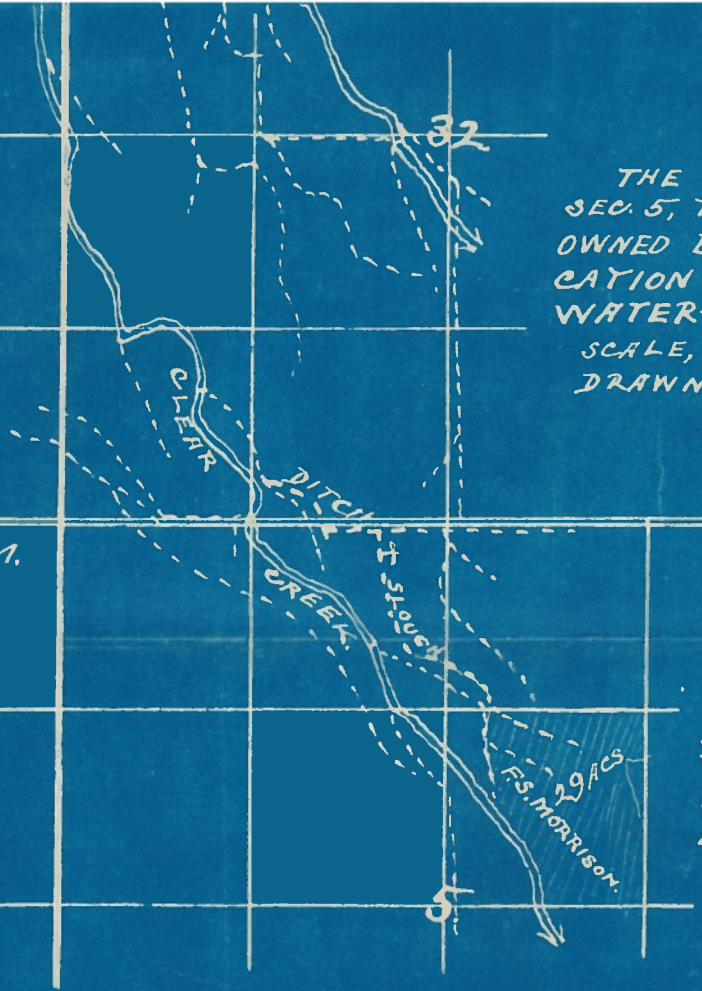
