Application History


On May 3, 2001, Tom and Bev Mallams submitted an application to the Department for a water use permit. The Department issued a Proposed Final Order on March 18, 2003. The protest period closed May 2, 2003, and no protest was filed.

The proposed use would not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Application G-15484 therefore is approved as proposed by the Proposed Final Order, and Permit G-15431 is issued as limited by the conditions proposed by the Proposed Final Order.
