As I related to you earlier today in our phone conversation, I am requesting an extension of the administrative hold on application G-15484. The 3 surgeries I had and the recovery time following has taken longer than we anticipated.

We feel confident that I will be able to continue our farming operation this Spring. We have already made loan applications to Farm Service Agency and Northwest Farm Credit Services in Klamath Falls. We also have estimates on the Well drilling, pumps and PP&L service needed. We feel the loan process should be done within 60-90 days and drilling to be done by the first of April, with the entire project to be completed by May 03.

Also, on our application, the initial review determination notes existing water rights on the ground we are proposing to irrigate from the new well. Permit 44513 and Permit 49262 will be cancelled when application G-15484 is completed. The .7 acre under certificate 50502 was already cancelled in 1980. Enclosed is a copy of the letter we received confirming this dated 8 April 1980.

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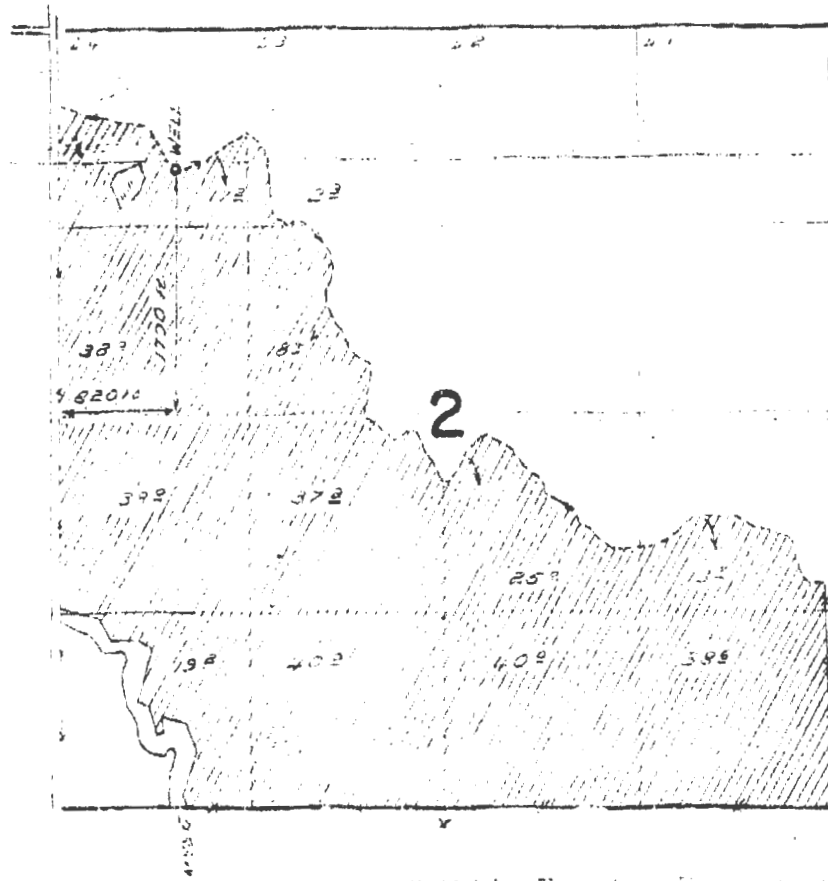

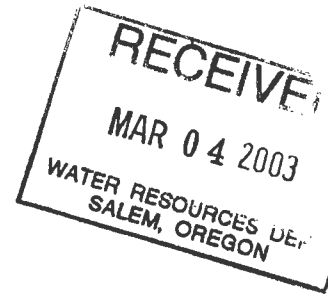
