

The Reservoir is used for irrigation water storage. Water is pumped from the Clackamas River into the Reservoir. A fish screen is located at the intake pipe, and a meter is installed to record the amount of water pumped. The Reservoir is lined with a crabber! liner which prevents water from seeping into the ground. The liner is susceptible to UV light damage and frost exposure clamage. These are the primary reasons we want to store water outside the irrigation season per the water right. The reservoir is also a habitat and home to many animals birds REBAY and amphibians.
