Enclosed please find official receipt No. 2151 for \$8.85 which amount was transmitted with your application for permit to appropriate water, and maps to accompany the filing. The application has been numbered 10016 and placed on file.

Before approving the application we would like to have for our records the size of the pipe you expect to install.

I also note that a part of the tract you expect to irrigate lies within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 24. If such is the case, it will be necessary for us to know the number of acres to be irrigated within each 40 acre tract.
