**PUBLIC INTEREST PRESUMPTION; GROUNDWATER**

**OAR 690-310-130 (1)** *The Department shall presume that a proposed groundwater use will ensure the preservation of the public welfare, safety and health as described in ORS 537.525. Department staff review groundwater applications under OAR 690-310-140 to determine whether the presumption is established. OAR 690-310-140 allows the proposed use be modified or conditioned to meet the presumption criteria. This review is based upon available information and agency policies in place at the time of evaluation.*

**B. GROUNDWATER AVAILABILITY CONSIDERATIONS, OAR 690-310-130, 400-010, 410-0070**

B3. **Groundwater availability remarks:** \_\_\_\_\_

Well yields in the area are relatively good, being generally greater than 10 gpm and as high as 100+ gpm. Well depths are generally less than 250 feet. Bedrock in the area consists of meta-sediments with some intrusives. The area lies near the contact between the granitic pluton and the meta-sediments (Wiley, 2006).

Groundwater development increased near the subject site over the last 10 years. There are several groundwater permits within ¼ mile radius of the proposed POA (see map). Water level data from these wells show a downward trend, with about 15 feet of head loss over the last 7 to 10 years (see hydrograph). This indicates that the fractured bedrock groundwater resource is currently being used at a higher rate than it is recharged by precipitation. Based on water level trends, further allocation is not likely within the capacity of the resource.

**Basis for aquifer confinement evaluation:** Nearby well logs drilled to similar depths report the static water level rises tens of feet about the water-bearing zone(s) in the fractured bedrock, indicating the target aquifer is more confined than unconfined.

**Basis for aquifer hydraulic connection evaluation:** \*Water level assumed to be similar to JACK 30970, which is similarly constructed and located approximately 260 feet to the northeast. Groundwater elevation is coincident with Slagle Creek, indicating hydraulic connection. Additionally, there is a flowing well on the topographic map in the vicinity of the subject site, indicating it is likely a groundwater discharge area.

**Comments:** \*Interference @ 30 d could not be estimated because the terrain (high-relief slopes) and geology (fractured bedrock aquifer) do not meet model assumptions of the widely accepted techniques for determining stream depletion (e.g., Hunt 1999, 2003).

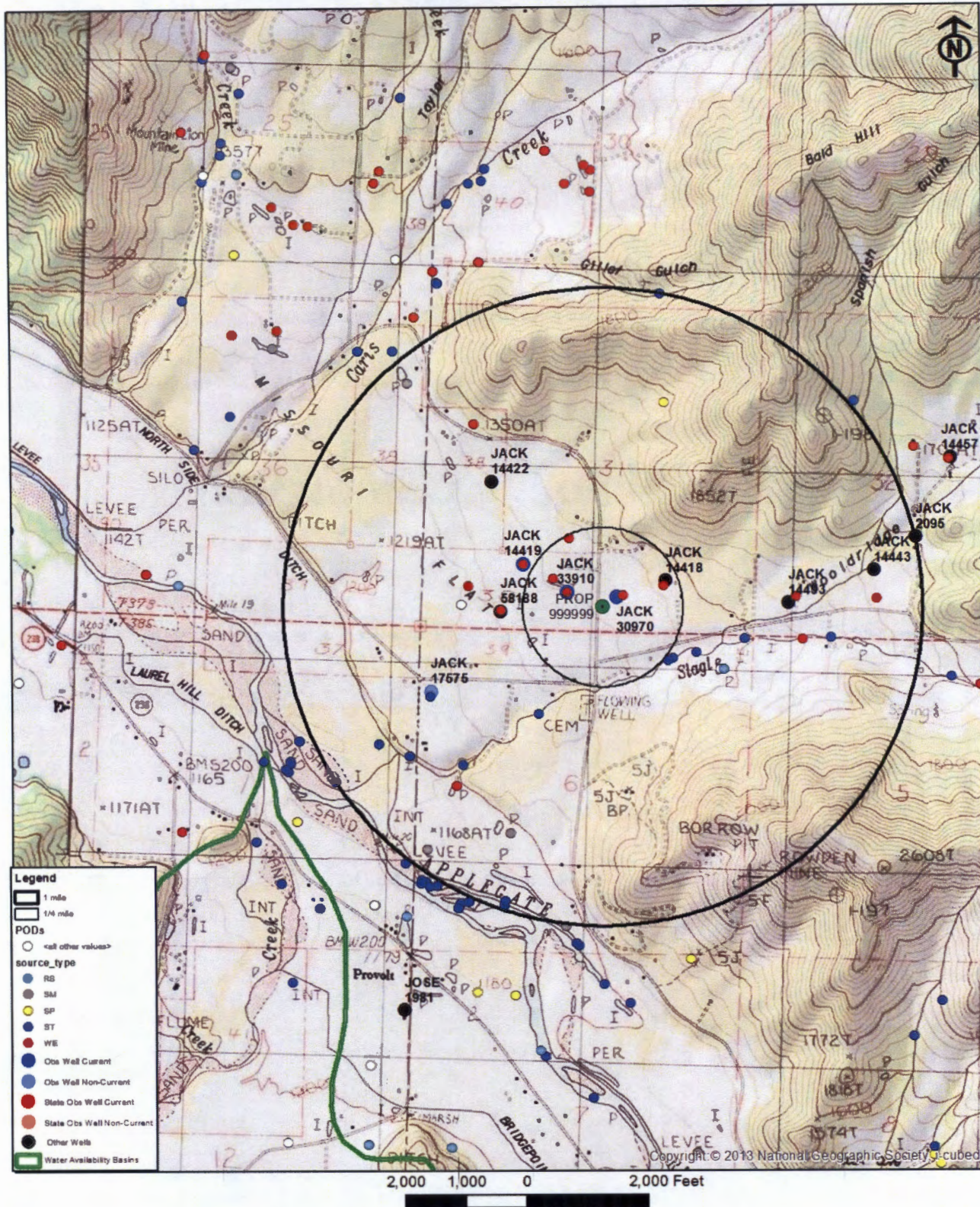
