

Water-Use Permit Application Processing

1. Completeness Determination

The Department evaluates whether the application and accompanying map contain all of the information required under OAR 690-310-0040 and OAR 690-310-0050 (www.oregon.gov/owrd/law.oar). The Department also determines whether the proposed use is prohibited by statute. If the Department determines that the application is incomplete, all fees have not been paid, or the use is prohibited by statute, the application and all fees submitted are returned to the applicant.

2. Initial Review

The Department reviews the application to determine whether water is available during the period requested, whether the proposed use is restricted or limited by rule or statute, and whether other issues may preclude approval of or restrict the proposed use. An Initial Review (IR) containing preliminary determinations is mailed to the applicant. The applicant has 14 days from the mailing date to withdraw the application from further processing and receive a refund of all fees paid minus \$200. The applicant may put the application on hold for up to 180 days and may request additional time if necessary.

3. Public Notice

Within 7 days of the mailing of the initial review, the Department gives public notice of the application in the weekly notice published by the Department at www.oregon.gov/owrd. The public comment period is 30 days from publication in the weekly notice.

4. Proposed Final Order Issued

The Department reviews any comments received, including comments from other state agencies related to the protection of sensitive, threatened or endangered fish species. Within 60 days of completion of the IR, the Department issues a Proposed Final Order (PFO) explaining the proposed decision to deny or approve the application. A PFO proposing approval of an application will include a draft permit, and may request additional information or outstanding fees required prior to permit issuance.

5. Public Notice

Within 7 days of issuing the PFO, the Department gives public notice in the weekly notice. Notice includes information about the application and the PFO. Protest must be received by the Department within 45 days after publication of the PFO in the weekly notice. Anyone may file a protest. The protest filing fee is \$350.00 for the applicant and \$700.00 for non-applicants. Protests are filed on approximately 10% of Proposed Final Orders. If a protest is filed the Department will attempt to settle the protest but will schedule a contested case hearing if necessary.

6. Final Order Issued

If no protests are filed, the Department can issue a Final Order within 60 days of the close of the period for receiving protest. If the application is approved, a permit is issued. 	Irrigation scheduling will be used to determine the crop water demand and the irrigation system will be operated only when water is needed. The length of set will be adjusted to meet the needs of each tree. The volume of water applied at each tree will be less when the trees are young and will increase each year as the trees grow. Using less-than-full irrigation will be considered to reduce the water requirements. Backflow protection equipment will be installed on each well to prevent irrigation water from running back into the aquifer.



 - b) The application involves a change in place of use only;
 - c) The change does not involve the placement or modification of structures, including but not limited to water diversion, impoundment, distribution facilities, water wells and well houses; and
 - d) The application involves irrigation water uses only.

NOTE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

The person presenting the attached Land Use Information Form is applying for or modifying a water right. The Water Resources Department (WRD) requires its applicants to obtain landuse information to be sure the water rights do not result in land uses that are incompatible with your comprehensive plan. Please complete the form or detach the receipt stub and return it to the applicant for inclusion in their water right application. You will receive notice once the applicant formally submits his or her request to the WRD. The notice will give more information about WRD's water rights process and provide additional comment opportunities. You will have 30 days from the date of the notice to complete the land-use form and return it to the WRD. If no land-use information is received from you within that 30-day period, the WRD may presume the land use associated with the proposed water right is compatible with your comprehensive plan. #9 Additional Remarks:

This permit application is for two parcels to be irrigated, owned by two different owners.

LeRoy Kropf is the applicant.

This application is for water rights that will be using water leased from the Bureau of Reclamation. The contract application has been submitted to the Bureau. The Bureau contract would be for water from the Mckenzie River, diverted near Coburg by the Muddy Creek Irrigation Project, and then delivered by the Muddy Creek Irrigation Project via the creek to the points of diversion listed in this application.

The parcel in drawing #1 (tax lot 400) is owned by **LeRoy Kropf and Anita Kropf Revocable Living Trust dated March 31, 2014.** The tax I.D. # for this trust is 540-66-1906.

A letter of permission from this trust is attached

The point of diversion for this parcel is on adjacent property (tax lot 905) owned by my mother's living trust, of which I am the trustee, and also have power of attorney to do business on behalf of my mother. Attached is a letter of permission from the trust to use a point of diversion and to convey water to the irrigated property (tax lot 400).

The parcels in drawing #2 are owned by Steve Smucker. The point of diversion is on tax lot 201, and the irrigated land is on tax lot 200. A letter of permission is attached granting permission to LeRoy Kropf to apply for water rights and use the water on these properties.
