

One acre hazelnut trees need 0.4 acre feet of water added per growing season. So, that means for my 58 acres, I'll need 23.2 acre feet of water (0.4 x 58 = 23.2). The remaining 3.8 acre feet I'll use on a bordering 6 acre field for row crop.

Again, this is a man-made reservoir and I have already planted fir trees & ash trees around most of it. Also, I seeded soil with perennial ryegrass seed for erosion control.

SECTION 9: REMARKS

I originally applied for and received permits from OWRD to build 2 reservoirs (R-87496 a R87486). However, R87486 (15 acre ft) turned out to not be a good reservoir site. So, I amended R87486 with OWRD to put the 15 acre feet of stored water at the same location as R-87496 (12 acre ft). So, the total water stored at the location of Gaffera Reservoir is 27 acre feet. My estimate of 12 acre feet on R-87496 turned out to be way too low because the pond depth turned out to be 25 feet deep in the center. Average pond depth is 15 ft and surface acreage is 1.8 acres so $15\text{-ft} \times 1.8\text{ acres} = 27\text{ acre feet}$ of water storage available. We got the increased pond depth by digging down into deep clay and using that clay removed to build the under 10 foot dike.
