Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

Permit S-54683 was issued by the Department on November 24, 2010. The permit called for completion of construction by November 24, 2015 and complete application of water to beneficial use by November 24, 2015. On November 24, 2015, Prosper Subdistrict of the Bandon Cranberry Water Control District submitted to the Department an Application for

Extension of Time for Permit S-54683. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on January 12, 2016, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction from 2015 to October 1, 2020 and the time to apply water to full beneficial use from 2015 to October 1, 2020. The protest period closed February 26, 2016, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings in the Proposed Final Order dated January 12, 2016.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, the permit may be extended subject to no additional conditions.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

ORDER

The extension of time for Application S-86225, Permit S-54683, therefore, is approved. The deadline for completing construction is extended from November 24, 2015 to October 1, 2020. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from November 24, 2015 to October 1, 2020.
