make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-7810, a tributary of Applegate River. KUBLI DITCH:

2. The point of diversion is to be located 2510 ft. S. and 3370 ft. W. from the NE corner of Long DLC 39, being within (Public Land Survey Corner)

being within the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 30, Tp. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.0 ac. ft stored water only cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Applegate Lake Res. const. under App. R-57600, Per. R-7810

The use to which this water is to be applied is supp. irr.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/2 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated 1 1/2
