



Certificate of Water Right Ownership Update

NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law, all water belongs to the public (ORS 537.110). In almost every instance, a permit or water right certificate from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting or storing water (ORS 537.130). However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A certificate of water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, the Department requests that this form be submitted to the Department. If for multiple rights, a separate form for each right will be required.

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Tualatin Hills Park and Recreation District of Washington County, Oregon, a Park and Recreation District, organized under the laws of the State of Oregon, hereinafter called the grantor, being lawfully seized in fee simple of the following described premises, does hereby dedicate to the use of the public as a public way forever, that certain real property situated in the City of Beaverton, County of Washington and State of Oregon, shown on the attached Exhibit "A" and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A portion of that tract of land situated in the East one-half of Section 7 and the West one-half of Section 8, Township 1 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Washington County, Oregon, conveyed to Tualatin Hills Park and Recreation District by Deed recorded at Document No. 82-01231, Washington County Book of Records, said portion being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at an angle point on the East line of the Edward Banton D.L.C. No. 37, said point being on the centerline of County Road No. 2444 (S.W. 170th Avenue); thence N 00°34'58" W along the centerline of said road a distance of 261.76 feet; thence N 89°56'30" E, 25.00 feet to the East right-of-way line of said S.W. 170th Avenue; also being the most Westerly west line of said Park tract and true point of beginning; thence continuing N 89°56'30" E along the boundary of said Park tract 20.00 feet to a point which is 45.00 feet Northeasterly from, when measured at right angles to the centerline of S.W. 170th Avenue; thence S 00°34'58" E parallel with the centerline of said S.W. 170th Avenue a distance of 263.17 feet; thence continuing parallel with the centerline of said road S 04°03'35" W a distance of 1700.78 feet to a point on the boundary of said Park tract; thence N 85°56'35" W along the boundary of said Park tract RECEIVED BY OWRD a distance of 20.00 feet to a point on the Easterly right-of-way line of said S.W. 170th Avenue; thence N 04°03'35" E along the said DEC 2 1 2015 Easterly right-of-way line a distance of 1699.97 feet; thence continuing along the Easterly right-of-way line of said S.W. 170th Avenue N 00°34'58" W a distance of 262.54 feet to the true point of beginning. SALEM, OR Contains 39,265 square feet, more or less. Basis of Bearing: Survey No. 19,709, Washington County Survey
