Certificate of Water Right Ownership Update

NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law, all water belongs to the public (ORS 537.110). In almost every instance, a permit or water right certificate from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting or storing water (ORS 537.130). However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A certificate of water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, the Department requests that this form be submitted to the Department. *If for multiple rights, a separate form for each right will be required.*

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That I. H. MILLS

of Paulina State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Grindstone Creek and Beaver Creek, tributaries of Crooked River; Tract No. 1, described below, being irrigated from Grindstone Creek; and Tracts Nos. 2 & 3 being irrigated with the waters of Beaver Creek;

for the purpose of the irrigation of 395 acres of land, and stock and domestic use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem,

in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1900 for the irrigation of lands in Tract No. 1; from 1903 for the irrigation of Tract No. 2; from 1898 for 75 acres in Tract No. 3; and from 1889 for the irrigation of 260 acres in Tract No. 3;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and 4.94 cubic feet per second from July 1st to September 15th of each year for irrigation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

20 acres in Tract No. 1, located as follows: 10 acres in the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4; 10 acres in the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4; Section Thirty-five (35), Township Eighteen (18) South Range Twenty-five (25) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

40 acres in Tract No. 2, located as follows: 15 acres in the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4; 5 acres in the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4; 6 acres in the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4; 14 acres in the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4; Section Five (5), Township Eighteen (18) South Range Twenty-six (26) East of Willamette Meridian, in Grant County, Oregon.

335 acres in Tract No. 3, located as follows: 35 acres in the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4; 30 acres in the SE 1/4 of SW 1/4; 27 acres in the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4; 10 acres in the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4; Section Seventeen (17); 8 acres in the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4; 8 acres in the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4; 24 acres in the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4; 40 acres in the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4; Section Eighteen (18); 22 acres in the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4; 27 acres in the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4; 20 acres in the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4; 33 acres in the SE 1/4 of NE 1/4; Section Nineteen (19); 11 acres in the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4; 25 acres in the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4; 15 acres in the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4; Section Twenty (20); all in Township Sixteen (16) South Range Twenty-four (24) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Note: The limited irrigation water right herein is a diversion and should conform to the decree as defined in the Decree. See document filed in support of Certificate #45.
