The assignment by proof from Scott Schaeffer and James Stanley, DBA Schaeffers Nursery to East Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District has been recorded in the records of the Water Resources Department.

Our records have been changed accordingly and the original request is enclosed. Receipt number 119782 covering the recording fee is also enclosed.

A permit is not a perfected water right, and has conditions and timelines that must be satisfied prior to a Certificate of Water Right being issued. Please review the permit to be familiar with the conditions and timelines contained in the permit.

Please note that this permit required complete application of water to the proposed use by October 1, 2006, and within one year after complete application of water to the proposed use, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner (CWRE). As of this date, the claim of beneficial use has not been received by the Department. This places this permit at risk of cancellation proceedings being started.
