Appeal Rights

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS

183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

Permit R-11622 was issued by the Department on April 18, 1996, and modified by Permit Amendment T-7619 on April 8, 1997. The permit called for actual construction to begin by April 18, 1997, completion of construction by October 1, 1998, and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 1999. On May 13, 2016, Stanford Oregon Hotel, LLC; Resort at the Mountain submitted an Application for Extension of Time for Permit R-11622. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on June 28, 2016, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction from October 1, 1998 to October 1, 2018 and the time to apply water to full beneficial use from October 1, 1999 to October 1, 2018. The protest period closed August 12, 2016, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings in the Proposed Final Order dated June 28, 2016.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, the permit may be extended subject to no additional conditions.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

ORDER

The extension of time for Application R-70850, Permit R-11622, therefore, is approved. The deadline for completing construction is extended from October 1, 1998 to October 1, 2018. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from October 1, 1999 to October 1, 2018.
